



THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

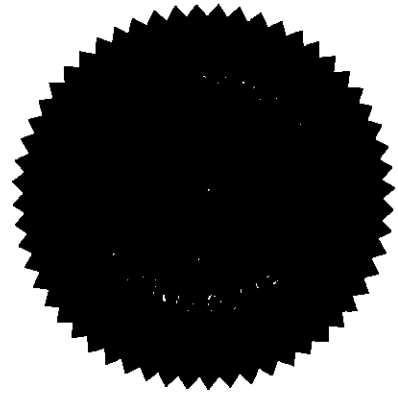
1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the car park adjacent to number 215 Fairfield Road to enter the Service Road to the rear of No's 215 to 241 Fairfield Road.
2. This Order will come into operation on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2002 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (SERVICE ROAD TO REAR OF No's 215 TO 241 FAIRFIELD ROAD, DROYLSDEN) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 2000"
