
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (CHURCH STREET SERVICE ROAD, DROYLSDEN) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2002

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule. (More clearly indicated on the attached plan).
- 2. This Order will come into operation on 21st. June 2002 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (CHURCH STREET SERVICE ROAD, DROYLSDEN) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2002".


