The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The order shall come into operation on 27th day of January 2012 and may be cited as 'THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (MANOR ROAD AND COOPER STREET, DROYLSDEN) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011'.
