

THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY

(ANNE STREET, MEADOW LANE, BIRCH LANE, DUKINFIELD)

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)(BOROUGH) ORDER 1978

THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1(1), (2), (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84(c) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the *20th March 1978* and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Anne Street, Meadow Lane, Birch Lane, Dukinfield)(Prohibition of Driving)(Borough) Order 1978.

SCHEDULE

Roads in the Metropolitan  
Borough of Tameside.

a. ANNE STREET

from its junction with Birch Lane for a distance of 8 metres in a north easterly direction.

from a point 17.5 metres north-east of its junction with Birch Lane for a distance of 6.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.

b. MEADOW LANE

from its junction with Birch Lane for a distance of 2.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.

c. BIRCH LANE

north-east side - a width of 2.5 metres from its junction with Meadow Lane, southwards to a point 18 metres north of the centre line of Boyds Walk.


