THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (DANTY STREET, DUKINFIELD) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (COUNTY) ORDER 1985

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule
- Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 31st March 1986 and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Danty Street, Dukinfield) (One-Way Traffic) (County) Order 1985.
