

BOROUGH OF HYDE (UNION STREET, WATER STREET, ONWARD STREET,
CORPORATION STREET AND OLDHAM STREET) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
ORDER, 1961.

The Hyde Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road in the Borough of Hyde specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

(b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;

(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;

Added by amending Order:-

(d) to enable any vehicle owned by a Funeral Director or owner of funeral vehicles to be used as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral.

← (e) or from causing or permitting ambulances to wait on the north-westerly side of Oldham Street within the north-westerly and south-easterly boundaries of the ambulance station forecourt.

3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960 or by or under any other enactment.

4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

5. The Order shall come into operation on the First day of December, 1961 and may be cited as "The Borough of Hyde (Union Street, Water Street, Onward Street, Corporation Street and Oldham Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961."

SCHEDULE

LENGTHS OF ROADS IN THE BOROUGH OF HYDE :

(1) Both sides of Union Street, between its junction with Market Street and a point opposite the easterly boundary of the ~~entrance to the Technical College.~~

All reference to Union Street inserted by Union Street (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1964.

(2) The northerly side of Union Street, between a point opposite the easterly boundary of the entrance to the Technical College and a point opposite the entrance to the Municipal Laundry.

(3) Water Street, between its junction with Manchester Road and its junction with Port Street.

(4) South East side of Onward Street, between its junction with Oldham Street and its junction with Henry Street.

(5) Corporation Street, between its junction with Market Street and its junction with Henry Street.

(6) Oldham Street, between its junction with Corporation Street and a point opposite the south-easterly boundary of the Ambulance Station. Deleted by Order No. 18.





Order:-


That the following sub-paragraph be added to paragraph 2 of the Borough of Hyde (Union Street, Water Street, Onward Street, Corporation Street and Oldham Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961:-

"or from causing or permitting ambulances to wait on the north-easterly side of Oldham Street within the north-westerly and south-easterly boundaries of the ambulance station frontage",

The Order shall come into operation on the TENTH day of SEPTEMBER, 1962, and may be cited as "The Borough of Hyde (Union Street, Water Street, Onward Street, Corporation Street and Oldham Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order, 1962".
