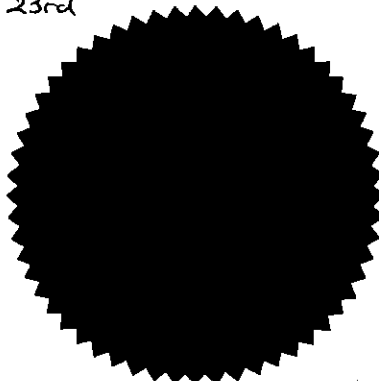
(HYDE TOWN CENTRE BY-PASS) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1987

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Hoviley from its junction with Clark Way to its junction with Reynard Street other than in that direction.
Reynold Street from its junction with Crook Street to its junction with Norfolk Street other than in that direction.
Crook Street from its junction with Union Street to its junction with Reynold Street other than in that direction.
Norfolk Street from its junction with Union Street to its junction with Reynold Street other than in that direction.
2. The Order shall come into operation on *14th day of August, 1987*, and may be cited as "The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Hyde Town Centre By-Pass) (One Way Traffic) Order 1987".
