THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Reynold Street, Hyde from its junction with Crook Street, Hyde to its junction with Norfolk Street other than in that direction.

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough (Hyde Town Centre By Pass)(One Way Traffic) Order 1987, shall have deleted therefrom the reference to Reynold Street from its junction with Crook Street to its junction with Norfolk Street other than in that direction.


