THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (HIGHAM LANE, HYDE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1981

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as the "County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1),(2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part 1X of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84c(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Higham Lane, Hyde from its junction with Mottram Old Road to a point 45 metres from that junction other than in a north westerly direction.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on 31st MANCH 1982 and may be cited as "The Greater Manchester County (Higham Lane, Hyde) (One Way Traffic) Order 1981".


