The Borough Council of Tameside (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section(s)1(1)(2) and (3) Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part II of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "the Act of 1967"), and of all other enabling powers (and with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Environment given under section 84B of the Act of 1967) and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Order shall come into operation on the August 1975 and may be cited as "THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (BACK BOWER LANE, HYDE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (BOROUGH) ORDER 1975
