

THE BOROUGH OF HYDE (ROWBOOTHAM STREET) (ONE-WAY STREET)

ORDER, 1973

The Hyde Borough Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

22. The Interpretation Act, 1959, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1973, and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF HYDE, (ROWBOOTHAM STREET) (ONE-WAY STREET) ORDER, 1973."

Road within the Borough of Hyde.

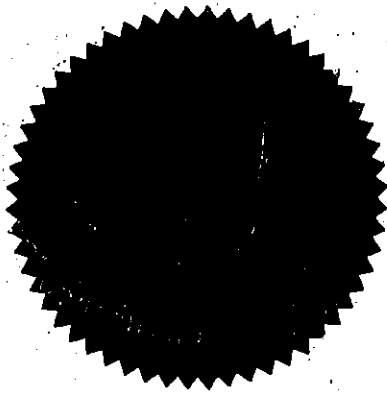
Rowbootham Street from its junction with Stockport Road to a point 44 metres from the kerb line of that junction.)))))
