

THE BOROUGH OF HYDE (SLATEACRE ROAD AND JOEL LANE) (PROHIBITION OF  
RIGHT HAND TURN) ORDER, 1968.

The Hyde Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and Section 2 (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf make the following Order :-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Slateacre Road, Hyde, in the County of Chester to make a right hand turn into Joel Lane.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the SEVENTEENTH day of JANUARY, 1969, and may be cited as "The Borough of Hyde (Slateacre Road and Joel Lane) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order, 1968."
