- 2. NO PERSON shall drive any vehicle in a westerly direction on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by the Order shall supersede any restrictions or requirements imposed by any other regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
