Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.

Under Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 the Teignbridge District Council hereby appoints the following Hackney Carriage stands:

- On the south side of Queen Street, Newton Abbot, from a point 34
 metres east of its junction with Devon Square Northern Spur for a
 distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction as shown with a dashed
 purple line on Plan No. 1 attached to this Order;
- On the south side of Queen Street, Newton Abbot, from a point six metres west of its junction with Prospect Terrace for a distance of 20 metres in a westerly direction as shown with a dashed purple line on Plan No.2 attached to this Order; and
- On the north side of East Street, Newton Abbot, from a point 13.5
 metres west of the east property boundary of number 27 East Street for
 a distance of 23.5 metres in a westerly direction as shown with a
 dashed purple line on Plan No.3 which can be used between 22.00
 hours 06.00 hours.
