

**TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, HADLEY & LEEGOMERY, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION & RESTRICTION**  
**OF WAITING & RESTRICTION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2013**

BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2013, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Hadley & Leegomery, Telford) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting & Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013.
2. (1) In this Order:-
  - "Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;
  - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.
  - "Parking Disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.
- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
  - (a) A Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-
    - (i) In the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
  - (b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (3) except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. Save as provided in Article 6 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule One of this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 6 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicles to wait on Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule Two of this order.
5. Save as provided in Article 6 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicles to wait on Monday to Friday, 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4pm on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule Three of this order.
6. (1) Nothing in Article 3, 4 and 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule Two to this order for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;

- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
  - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
  - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3, 4 and 5 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule Two to this Order, at any time.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3, 4 and 5 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
- (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
- (4) Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
7. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule Four of this order.
8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

**Schedule One - (Prohibition of Waiting)**

Grainger Drive, Leegomery (North side)	From a point approximately 134m west of the centreline of Kingfisher Way to a point approximately 24m east of the centreline of Heatherdale.
Grainger Drive, Leegomery (South side)	From a point approximately 129m west of the centreline of Kingfisher Way to a point approximately 24m east of the centreline of Heatherdale.
Kingfisher Way, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its western junction with Grainger Drive for a distance of approximately 29m in a south easterly direction. From its eastern junction with Grainger Drive for a distance of approximately 46m in a southerly direction.
Kestrel Court, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Kingfisher Way for a distance of approximately 9m in a easterly direction.
Teresa Way, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Grainger Drive to a point approximately 11m north east of the centreline of Fleming Court.
Cavell Close, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Teresa Way for a distance of approximately 10m in a westerly direction.
Curie Croft, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Teresa Way for a distance of approximately 11m in a north westerly direction.
Fleming Court, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Teresa Way for a distance of approximately 10m in a south easterly direction.
Heatherdale, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Grainger Drive for a distance of approximately 30m in a south easterly direction.
Turnstone Drive, Leegomery (East side)	From its junction with Grainger Drive to its junction with Dunlin Close.
Pool Farm Avenue, Leegomery (West side)	From a point approximately 22m south of the centreline of Royal Oak Drive for a distance of approximately 45m in a northerly direction.
Royal Oak Drive, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Pool Farm Avenue for a distance of approximately 13m in a westerly direction.
Lawton Farm Way, Leegomery (Both sides)	From its junction with Pool Farm Avenue to its junction with Lawton Farm Close.
Leegate Avenue, Hadley (North east side)	From a point approximately 28m north west of the centreline of Hadley Park Road for a distance of approximately 51m in a south easterly direction.
Hadley Park Road, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Leegate Avenue for a distance of approximately 20m in a north easterly direction.
Hadley Park Road, Hadley (East side)	From a point approximately 49m north east of its junction with Leegate Avenue for a distance of approximately 71m in a northerly direction.
Hadley Park Road, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Hadley Park Road for a distance of approximately 16m in a south easterly direction.
High Street, Hadley (South side)	From a point approximately 20m north west of the centreline of Manse Road to a point approximately 67m east of the centreline of Manse Road. From a point approximately 11m south east of the centreline of Cyril Hayward Court for a distance of approximately 20m in a north westerly direction.
High Street, Hadley (West side)	From its junction with Britannia Way for a distance of approximately 47m in a southerly direction.

High Street, Hadley (East and north side)	From its junction with Britannia Way to a point approximately 67m east of the centreline of Manse Road.
High Street, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Stadium Way to a point approximately 26m west of the centreline of Gladstone Street.
High Street, Hadley (North east side)	From a point approximately 17m north west of the centreline of Cyril Hayward Court for a distance of approximately 17m in a north westerly direction.
High Street Service Road, Hadley (Both side)	For the entire length of the High Street Service Road that runs easterly from High Street.
Gladstone Street, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 13m in a southerly direction.
Cyril Hayward Court, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 6m in a south westerly direction.
Manse Road, Hadley (West side)	From its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 47m in a southerly direction.
Manse Road, Hadley (East side)	From its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 15m in a southerly direction.
Crescent Road, Hadley (Both sides)	For the entire length of the turning head area up to the westerly building line of property 68.  From a point approximately 23m north east of the centreline of Mafeking Road for a distance of approximately 45m in a south westerly direction.
Mafeking Road, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Crescent Road for a distance of approximately 24m in a north westerly direction.
Waterloo Road, Hadley (East side)	From a point approximately 11m south of the centreline of Waterloo Close for a distance of approximately 32m in a northerly direction.
Waterloo Close, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Waterloo Road for a distance of approximately 10m in a easterly direction.
Castle Street, Hadley (South east side)	From a point approximately 50m south west of the centreline of Castle Lane to its junction with Trench Lock.
Castle Street, Hadley (North west side)	From a point approximately 14m south west of the centreline of Castle Lane to its junction with Trench Lock.
Trench Lock, Hadley (Both sides)	From its junction with Castle Street to a point approximately 16m south west of its junction with Sommerfeld Road.  From a point approximately 8m north east of its junction with Sommerfeld Road for a distance of approximately 32m in a north easterly direction.
Sommerfeld Road, Hadley (South west side)	From a point approximately 8m south east of its junction with Trench Lock to a point approximately 14m south east of the centreline of Oakworth Close.
Sommerfeld Road, Hadley (North east side)	From a point approximately 8m south east of its junction with Trench Lock to a point approximately 24m north west of the centreline of Oakworth Close.

Crescent Road, Hadley (Both sides)	For the entire length of the turning head area up to the westerly building line of property number 54.

Turnstone Drive, Leegomery (West side)	From a point approximately 7m north west of its junction with Grainger Drive for a distance of approximately 44m in a northerly direction.
Pool Farm Avenue, Leegomery (North west side)	From a point approximately 12m north east of the centreline of Lawton Farm Way for a distance of approximately 44m in a north easterly direction.
Crescent Road, Hadley (South side)	From a point approximately 26m west of the centreline of Manse Road for a distance of approximately 26m in a westerly direction.  From a point approximately 8m west of the centreline of Manse Road for a distance of approximately 26m in a easterly direction.
