

**TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, NEWPORT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, ON STREET**  
**PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2013**

BOROUGH OF TELFORD AND WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2013, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport) (Prohibition of Waiting, On Street Parking Places and Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013.

2. (1) In this Order:-

"Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.

"Parking Disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square and coloured blue, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and

(b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

(3) except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 4 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the roads specified in Schedule One of this Order.

4. (1) Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
  - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
  - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule One to this Order, at any time.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
- (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
- (4) Nothing in Articles 3 or 5 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
5. (1) Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm on Monday

to Saturday on the roads specified in Schedule Two of this Order.

(a) For a longer period than 40 minutes; or

(b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting by that vehicle.

- (2) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- (3) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
6. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00am 5.00pm, Monday to Friday on of the road specified in Schedule Three of this Order.
7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

<b>Schedule One - (Prohibition of Waiting)</b>

Audley Road, Newport (North side)	From its junction with Meadow Road for a distance of approximately 17m in a westerly direction.
Audley Road, Newport (South side)	From its junction with Meadow Road to its junction with Stafford Street.
Audley Road, Newport (North east side)	From its junction with Stafford Street for a distance of approximately 91m in a south easterly direction.
Audley Road, Newport (South east side)	From its junction with Meadow Road for a distance of approximately 27m in a south westerly direction.
Chetwynd End, Newport (East side)	From its junction with Forton Road to a point approximately 74m south of the centreline of Forton Road.  From its junction with Water Lane to a point approximately 112m north of the centreline of Water Lane.
Chetwynd End, Newport (West side)	From its junction with Forton Road to its junction with Water Lane.
Chetwynd Grove, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Forton Road for a distance of approximately 22m in a easterly direction.
Chetwynd Road, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Forton Road for a distance of approximately 50m in a northerly direction.

Chetwynd Road, Newport (West side)	From a point approximately 47m north of the centreline of Edgmond Road for a distance of 74m in a southerly direction.
Cornmell Lea, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Meadow Road for a distance of approximately 14m in a westerly direction.
Edgmond Road, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Chetwynd Road for a distance of approximately 40m in a westerly direction.
Forton Road, Newport (Both Sides)	From its junction with Chetwynd Road to a point approximately 43m north of the centreline of Chetwynd Grove.
Lower Bar, Newport (North east side)	From its junction with Water Lane to a point approximately 37m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane.  From a point approximately 68m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane for a distance of approximately 29m in a south easterly direction.
Lower Bar, Newport (South west side)	From its junction with Waters Lane to a point approximately 45m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane.  From a point approximately 87m south east of the centreline of Salters lane for a distance of approximately 29m in a south easterly direction.
Meadow Road, Newport (North west side)	From its junction with Audley Road for a distance of approximately 33m in a north easterly direction.
Meadow Road, Newport (South east side)	From its junction with Audley Road for a distance of approximately 38m in a north easterly direction.
Meadow Road, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Meadow Road to its junction with Cornmell Lea.
Tan Bank, Newport (South west side)	From its junction with Vineyard Road to its junction with Water Lane.
Vineyard Road, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Water Lane to its junction with Victoria Park.
Water Lane, Newport (South side)	From its junction with Lower Bar for a distance of approximately 168m in a generally easterly direction.
Water Lane, Newport (North side)	From its junction with Lower Bar for a distance of approximately 164m in a generally easterly direction.
Water Lane, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Safford Street to its junction with Vineyard Road.
<b>Schedule Two - (On Street Parking Places) Monday to Saturday – 8am to 6pm - 40 minutes No Return Within 1 hour</b>	
<b>Column One</b>	<b>Column Two</b>
Lower Bar, Newport (North east side)	From a point approximately 37m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane for a distance of approximately 30m in a south easterly direction.  From a point approximately 97m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane for a distance of approximately 12m in a south easterly direction.

Lower Bar, Newport (South west side)	From a point approximately 45m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane for a distance of approximately 42m in a south easterly direction.
<b>Schedule Three - (Restriction of Stopping) – Monday to Friday – 8am to 5pm</b>	
Chetwynd End, Newport (East Side)	From a point approximately 17m south west of the centreline of Forton Road for a distance of approximately 44m in an south westerly direction.
