

**TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, NEWPORT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF**  
**LOADING, ON STREET PARKING PLACES, ON STREET DISABLED PARKING**  
**PLACES, ON STREET LOADING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING)**  
**ORDER 2013**

BOROUGH OF TELFORD AND WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2013, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport) (Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Loading, On Street Parking Places, On Street Disabled Parking Places, On Street Loading Places and Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013

2. (1) In this Order:-

"Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square coloured blue, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and

(b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

(3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 5 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One of this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 6 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Two to this Order.
5. (1) Nothing in Articles 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
  - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
  - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, at any time.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
  - (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place

- (4) Nothing in Article 3 or 7 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
6. (1) Nothing in Article 4 or 9 of this Order shall apply:-
- (a) if it is being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or local authority purposes in an emergency situation.
7. (1) Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm on Monday to Saturday on the roads specified in Schedule Three of this Order.
- (a) For a longer period than 40 minutes; or
- (b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting by that vehicle.
8. (1) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the roads specified in Schedule Four of this Order unless.
- (a) Displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge and Parking Disc.
9. (1) Save as provided in Article 10 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the roads specified in Schedule Five of this Order unless.
- (a) It is for the purpose of loading and unloading of goods and merchandise to or from premises situated adjacent to the length of road.
10. (1) Nothing in Articles 9 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
- (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the

Telecommunications Act 1984.

- (b) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
  - (d) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
11. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place of the type in Articles 7, 8 or 9 shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
  12. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place of the type in Articles 7, 8 or 9, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
  13. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday on of the road specified in Schedule Six of this Order.
  14. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

Beaumaris Road, Newport (South side)	From its junction with New Street for a distance of approximately 25m in a westerly direction.
Beaumaris Road, Newport (North east side)	From its junction with New Street for a distance of approximately 87m in a north westerly direction.
Gravelly Drive, Newport (North west side)	From a point approximately 17m west of the centreline of Sandiford Crescent to its junction with Beaumaris Road.
Gravelly Drive, Newport (South east side)	From a point approximately 17m west of the centreline of Sandiford Crescent for a distance of 81m in a generally north easterly direction.  From its junction with Beaumaris Road for a distance of approximately 8m in a south westerly direction.
High Street, Newport (North east side)	From a point approximately 156m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane to a point approximately 2m north west of the centreline of New Street.  From a point approximately 34m south east of the centreline of New Street for a distance of approximately 11m in a south easterly direction.

	From its southern junction with St Mary Street to a point approximately 212m north of the centreline of Wellington Road.
High Street, Newport (East side)	From a point approximately 132m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 16m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 72m north of the centreline of Wellington Road to its junction with Avenue Road.
High Street, Newport (South west side)	From a point approximately 206m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane to a point approximately 219m north of the centreline of Wellington Road.
High Street, Newport (West side)	From a point approximately 207m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 5m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 173m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 6m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 159m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 8m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 127m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 14m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 104m north of the centreline of Wellington Road for a distance of approximately 6m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 87m north of the centreline of Wellington Road to its junction with Wellington Road.
New Street, Newport (East side)	From its junction with High Street to a point approximately 134m south of its junction with High Street.  From its junction with Beaumaris Road to a point approximately 25m north of the centreline of Beaumaris Road.
New Street, Newport (West side)	From its junction with High Street to a point approximately 80m south of its junction with High Street.  From its junction with Beaumaris Road to a point approximately 92m south of its junction with High Street.
Roddam Court, Newport (South side)	From its junction with Sandiford Crescent for a distance of approximately 135m in an easterly direction.
Roddam Court, Newport (North side)	From its junction with Sandiford Crescent for a distance of approximately 54m in an easterly direction.
Roddam Court, Newport (Both side)	From its junction with Roddam Court for a distance of approximately 7m in a northerly direction.
Roddam Court, Newport (North & East side)	From a point approximately 80m east of the centreline of Roddam Court for a distance of approximately 31m in a generally northerly direction.
Salters Lane, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Upper Bar to its junction with Ashley Court.

Sandiford Crescent, Newport (South west side)	From its junction with Gravelly Drive to its junction with Roddam Court.
Sandiford Crescent, Newport (North east side)	From its junction with Gravelly Drive for a distance of approximately 25m in a south easterly direction.
Sandiford Crescent, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with Sandiford Crescent for a distance of approximately 13m in a westerly direction.
St Mary's Street, Newport (North east side)	From its southerly junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 28m in a northerly direction.
St Mary's Street, Newport (South west side)	From its southern junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 125m in a northerly direction.  From a point approximately 190m north of its southern junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 28m in a northerly direction.
St Mary's Street, Newport (South east side)	From a point approximately 191m of its southern junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 13m in a south westerly direction.
St Mary's Street, Newport (North west side)	From a point approximately 198m north of its southern junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 10m in a south westerly direction.
Stafford Street, Newport (Both sides)	From its junction with High Street to its junction with Audley Avenue.

**Schedule Two – (Prohibition of Loading)**

Stafford Street, Newport (North west side)	From a point approximately 136m south west of the centreline of Waters Lane to its junction with Waters Lane.  From a point approximately 163m south west of the centreline of Waters Lane to its junction with High Street.
Stafford Street, Newport (South east side)	From its junction with High Street to its junction with Audley Road.


