

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, NEWPORT AND EDGMOND) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING,
PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING, ON STREET PARKING PLACES
AND ON STREET LOADING PLACES) ORDER 2015

BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 31 March 2016 and may be cited as the Borough of Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport and Edgmond) (Prohibition of Waiting, Prohibition of Waiting and Loading, On Street Parking Places and On Street Loading Places) Order 2015.

2. (1) In this Order:-

"Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.

"Loading Bay Area" means a length of road indicated by traffic signs authorised to be used by vehicles in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

"Parking Disc" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

"Parking Place" means a length of road indicated by traffic signs authorised to be used by vehicles in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and

(b) a Parking Disc is in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

(3) except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait at any time, on all days on the sides of the roads specified in Column 1 Schedule 1 and along the lengths of those roads described in Column 2 Schedule 1.
4. (1) Nothing in Articles 3, 7, 8 and 9 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3, 7, 8 and 9 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
 - (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
5. Nothing in Article 3, 7 and 8 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, at any time.
6. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Person's Badge and a Disabled Person's Parking Disc (on which the badge holder or person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to park, stop

or wait for a period not exceeding three (3) hours on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in the said Articles. Any vehicle permitted to park, stop or wait on the said sides of lengths of roads by virtue of this Article 6 must not return to park, stop or wait on the same sides of lengths of roads within one (1) hour after leaving.

7.
 - (1) Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday in a Parking Place as described in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 for a period longer than thirty (30) minutes.
 - (2) Any vehicle permitted to park, stop or wait in a Parking Place by virtue of Article 7 (1) is not permitted to return to any Parking Place on the same sides of lengths of roads within one (1) hour after leaving.
8.
 - (1) Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday in a Parking Place as described in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 3 for a period longer than forty (40) minutes.
 - (2) Any vehicle permitted to park, stop or wait in a Parking Place by virtue of Article 8 (1) is not permitted to return to any Parking Place on the same sides of lengths of roads within one (1) hour after leaving.
9.
 - (1) The prohibitions in Articles 7 and 8 shall not apply to a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Person's Badge.
 - (2) The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place as described in Schedules 3, 4 and 5 shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place; and
 - (3) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
10.
 - (1) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait at any time, Monday to Saturday in a Loading Bay Area as described in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 unless:-
 - (a) it is for the purpose of loading and unloading goods from the vehicle to or from premises situated adjacent to the Loading Bay Area.
 - (2) The driver of a vehicle using a Loading Bay Area shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Loading Bay Area and shall not start the engine except when about to change position of the vehicle or to depart from the Loading Bay Area.
 - (3) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a Loading Bay Area, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Loading Bay Area, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.

11. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

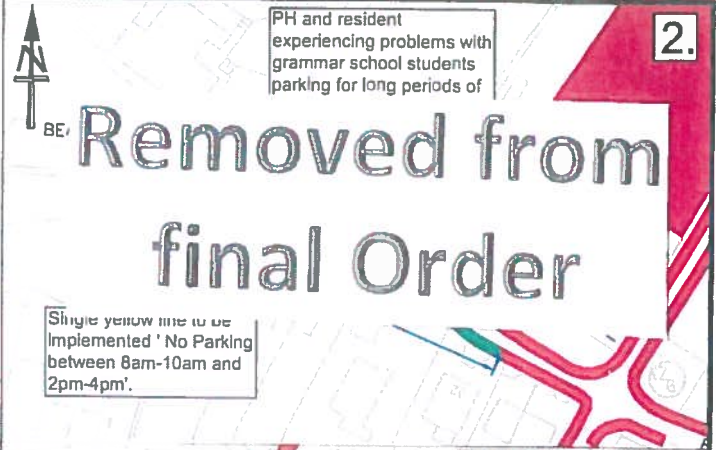

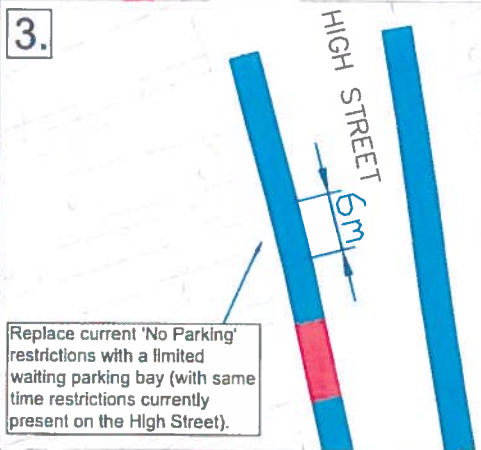

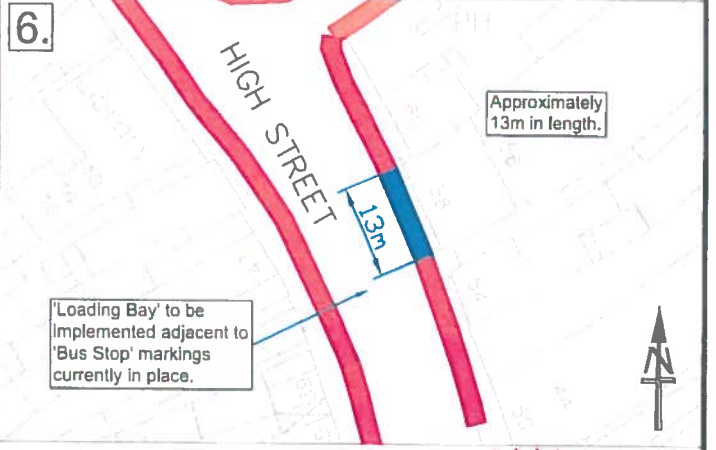

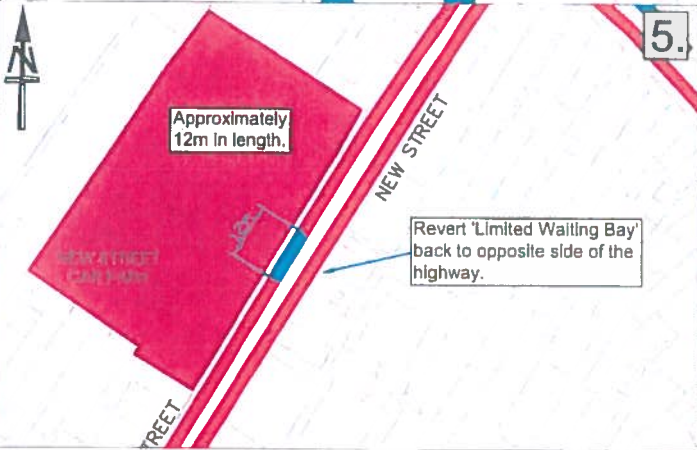
Replace current 'No Parking' restrictions with a limited waiting parking bay (with same time restrictions currently present on the High Street).

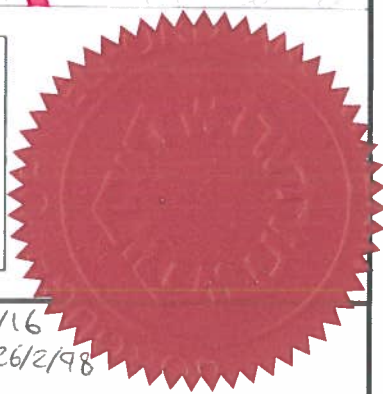
