

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS HADLEY, LEEGOMERY, HORTONWOOD AND LILLESBALL)
(VARIATION, PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND ON STREET PARKING PLACES)
ORDER 2015

BOROUGH OF TELFORD AND WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Section 1, 2, 4 and 32 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 31 March 2016, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Hadley, Leegomery, Hortonwood and Lilleshall) (Variation, Prohibition of Waiting and On Street Parking Places) Order 2015.
2. The restrictions in respect of Crescent Road, Hadley (South) as described in Columns 1 and 2 Schedule 4 of Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Hadley & Leegomery, Telford) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting & Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013 shall cease to have effect

3. (1) In this Order:-

"Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984.

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.

"Parking Disc" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

"Parking Place" means a length of road indicated by traffic signs authorised to be used by vehicles in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle; and

(b) a Parking Disc is in the relevant position when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered

Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

4. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait at any time on all days on the sides of the roads specified in Column 1 Schedule 1 and along the lengths of those roads described in Column 2 Schedule 1.
5.
 - (1) Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait at all times, Monday to Saturday in a Parking Place as described in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 for a period longer than thirty (30) minutes.
 - (2) Any vehicle permitted to park, stop or wait in a said Parking Place by virtue of article 5 (1) is not permitted to return to any Parking Place on the same side of lengths of roads within one (1) hour after leaving.
 - (3) The prohibitions in Articles 5 (1) and 5 (2) shall not apply to a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Person's Badge.
 - (4) The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
 - (5) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a Parking Place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
6.
 - (1) Nothing in Articles 4 or 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides and along the lengths of the roads referred to in the said articles for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any

other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) a vehicle to park, stop or wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to park, stop or wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads referred to in the said Articles.
- (3) Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
- (a) To park, stop or wait upon an Authorised Parking Place

7. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the badge holder or person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to park, stop or wait for a period not exceeding three (3) hours on any of the sides of the lengths of roads referred to in the said Articles. Any vehicle permitted to park, stop or wait on the said sides of lengths of roads by virtue of this Article 7 must not return to park, stop or wait on the same sides of lengths of roads within one (1) hour after leaving.

8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

(1) High Street (South side)	From a point 67m east of the centreline of its junction with Manse Road for a distance of 74m in a south easterly direction.
(2) High Street (North side)	From a point 131m east of the centreline of its junction with Manse Road for a distance of 20m in a south easterly direction.
(3) Manse Road (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Crescent Road for a distance of 10m in a northerly direction.
(4) Crescent Road cul de sac (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Crescent Road for a distance of 10m in a northerly direction.

(5) Gladstone Street (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Crescent Road for a distance of 10m in a northerly direction.
(6) Crescent Road (North side)	From a point 24m west of the centreline of its junction with Manse Road for a distance of 44m in a easterly direction.
(7) Crescent Road (North side)	From a point 22m west of the centreline of its junction with Crescent Road cul de sac for a distance of 43m in a easterly direction.
(8) Crescent Road (North side)	From a point 20m west of the centreline of its junction with Gladstone Street for a distance of 38m in a easterly direction.
(9) Crescent Road (South side)	From a point 18m east of the centreline of its junction with Gladstone Street for a distance of 306m in a westerly direction.
Leegomery	
(10) Hadley Park Road (West side)	From the centreline of its junction with the Orchards for a distance of 10m in a north westerly direction
(11) Hadley Park Road (West side)	From a point 7m north of its junction with Park Court (private road) for a distance of 12m in a northerly direction.
(12) Royal Oak Drive (both sides)	From a point 12m west of the centreline of its junction with Pool Farm Avenue for a distance of 27m in a easterly direction.
(13) Royal Oak Drive (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Royal Oak Drive for a distance of 12m in a southerly direction.
Lilleshall	
(14) Limekiln Lane (both sides)	From a point 20m south west of the centreline of its junction with Willmoor Lane for a distance of 30m in a south westerly direction.
Hortonwood	
(15) Hortonwood 60 (both sides)	From a point 42m east of the centreline of its junction with Hortonwood 65 for a distance of 90m in a easterly direction.
(16) Hortonwood 60 (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Hortonwood 50 for a distance of 40m in a westerly direction.
(17) Hortonwood 50 (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Hortonwood 60 for a distance of 126m in a southerly direction.
(18) Hortonwood 50 (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Hortonwood 60 for a distance of 20m in a northerly direction.
(19) Horton Court (both sides)	From the centreline of its junction with Hortonwood 50 for a distance of 10m in a easterly direction.

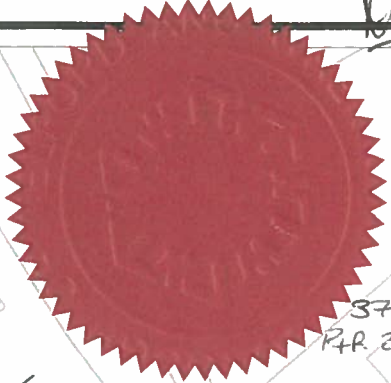

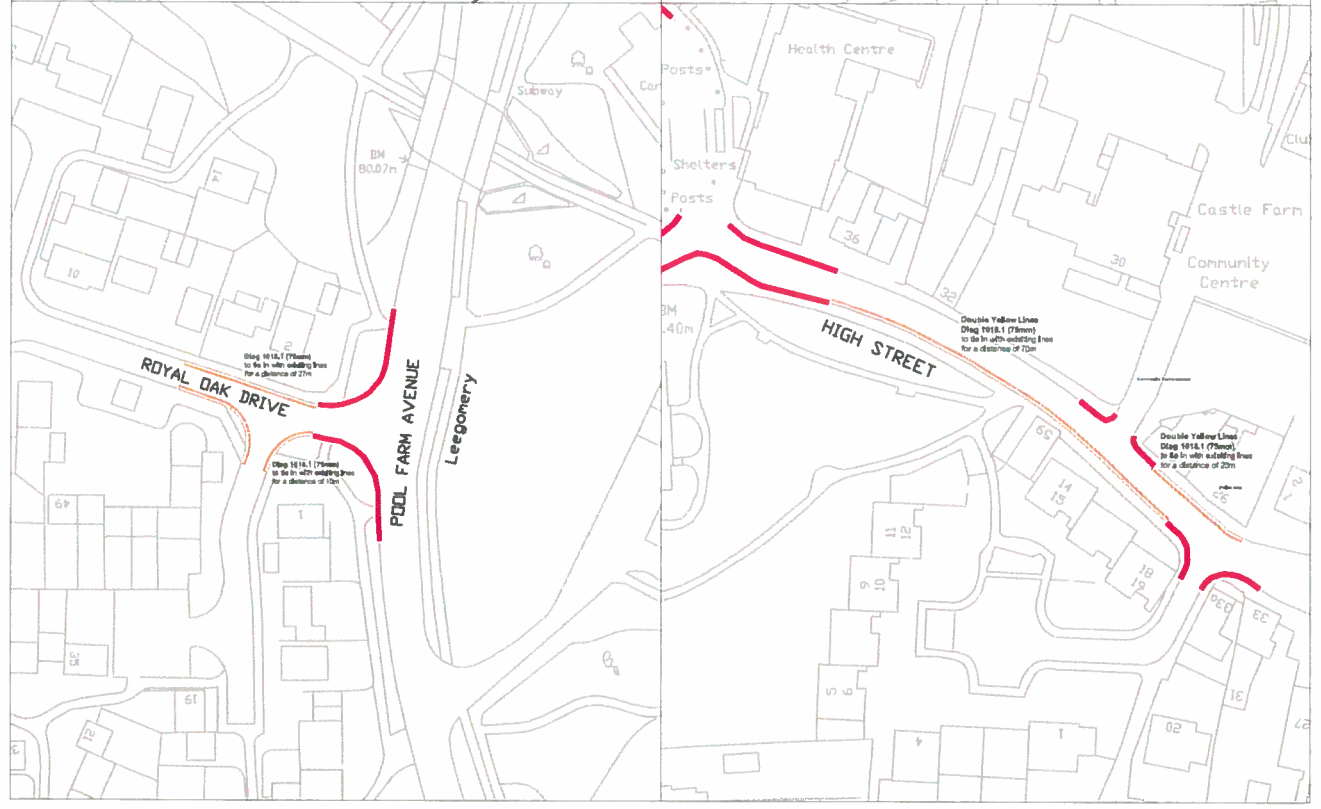
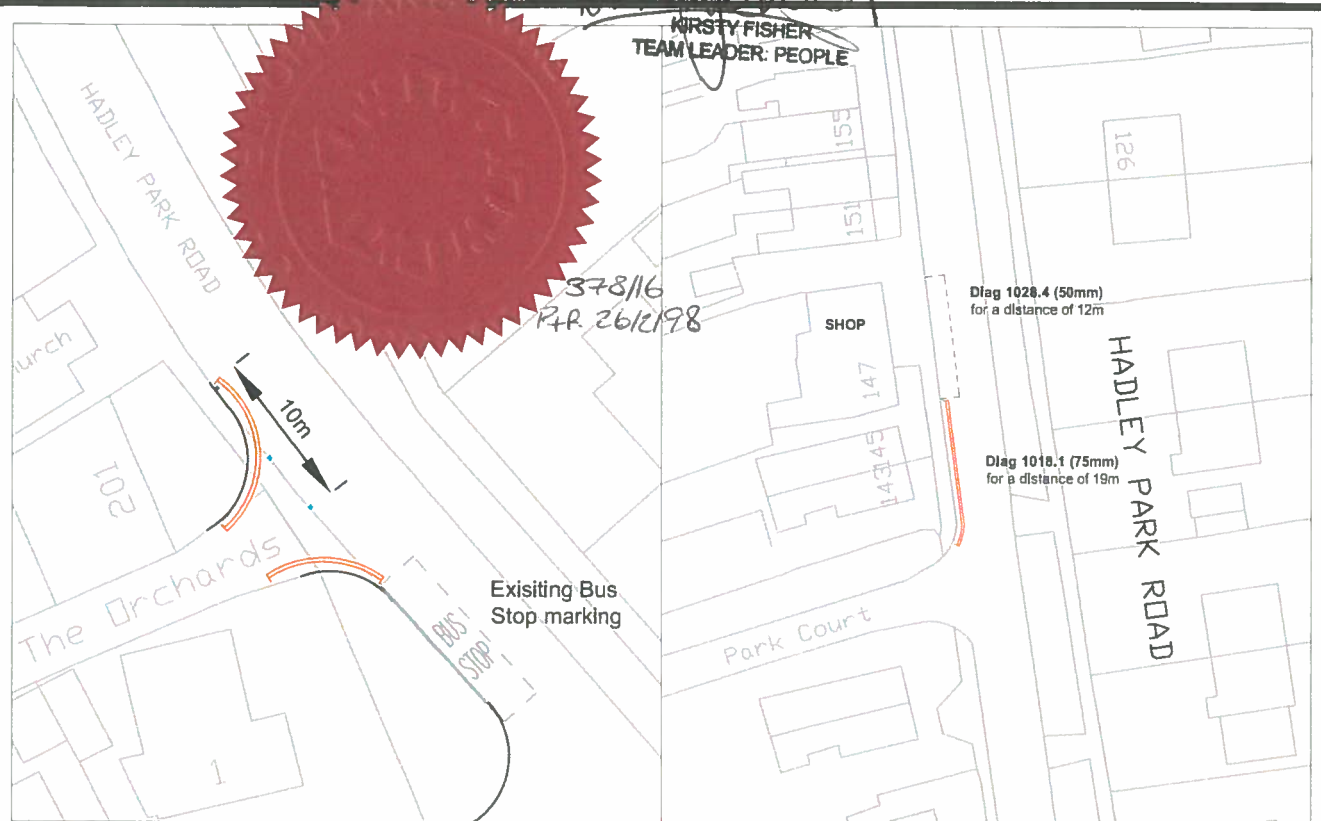
