

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, WROCKWARDINE WOOD & TRENCH, TELFORD)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING & RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019

BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6th June 2019, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Wrockwardine Wood & Trench, Telford) (Prohibition of Waiting & Restriction of Waiting) Order 2019.
2. The Orders specified in Schedule of Revocation of this Order shall be varied as set out in that Schedule.
3. (1) In this Order:-
 - "Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;
 - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.
 - "Parking Disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
 - (a) A Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-
 - (i) In the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
 - (b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.(3) except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
4. (1) Nothing in Article 6 or 7 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 to this order for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-

- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 6 or 7 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Order, at any time.
 - (3) Nothing in Article 6 or 7 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
 - (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
 - (4) Nothing in Articles 6 or 7 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
 6. Save as provided in Article 4 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

7. Save as provided in Article 4 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicles to wait on Monday to Friday, 7.45am to 9.15am and 2.15pm to 3.45pm on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this Order

Church Road, Trench (North east side)	From a point approximately 61m south east of the centerline of its northern junction with Woodhouse Crescent to a point approximately 16m east of the centreline of its southern junction with Woodhouse Crescent. From a point approximately 31m south east of the centreline of Pickering Road to a point approximately 27m north west of the centreline of Pickering Road.
Pickering Road, Trench (Both sides)	From its junction with Church Road for a distance of approximately 15m in a south westerly direction.
Trench Road, Trench (North west side)	From a point approximately 41m south west of the centreline of Tudor Meadow for a distance of approximately 33m in a south westerly direction.

Church Road, Telford (the north-east side)	<p>from a point 61 metres south-east of its Northern junction with Woodhouse Crescent in a southerly direction to its Southern junction with Woodhouse Crescent</p> <p>from its junction with Woodhouse Crescent in a south easterly direction to a point approximately 11 metres north-west of its junction with Malcolm Davies Drive</p>
2. Dickins Road, Telford (both sides)	from its junction with Wade Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres
3. Gibbons Road, Telford (the north-east side)	from a point approximately 10 meters south-east of its junction with Dickins Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 28 meters
4. Pickering Road, Telford (the north-west side)	from its junction with Church Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Richmond Avenue
5. Pickering Road, Telford (the south-east side)	from its junction with Church Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Richmond Avenue
6. Trench Road, Telford (the north-west side)	From a point approximately 41 metres south west of the centreline of Tudor Meadow in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 65 metres.

1. Gibbons Road, Telford (the north-east side)	from its junction with Wade Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Dickins Road
2. Gibbons Road, Telford (the south-west side)	from its junction with Wade Road in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 44 metres
3. New Road (North Of Wrockwardine Wood Way), Telford (the east side)	from the centreline of its junction with Chapel Terrace (No. 13-20) in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 56 metres
4. New Road (North Of Wrockwardine Wood Way), Telford (the west side)	from its junction with the Leisure Centre entrance in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 51 metres
5. Wade Road, Telford (the north-east side)	from a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Church Road in a northerly direction from its junction with Gibbons Road.
6. Wade Road, Telford (the west side)	from a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Church Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Gibbons Road
