

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, WELLINGTON, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION & RESTRICTION OF
WAITING AND ON STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019

BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on Thursday 31st October 2019, and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Wellington, Telford) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting and On Street Parking Places) Order 2019.

 2. (1) In this Order:-
 - "Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act;

 - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.

 - "Parking Disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

 - (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
 - (a) A Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-
 - (i) In the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and

 - (b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

 - (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. (1) Nothing in Articles 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One to this order for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;

 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;

- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of the lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 5, 6 or 9 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule One, Two and Five to this Order, at any time.
 - (3) Nothing in Article 5, 6, 7 ,8 or 9 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
 - (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
 - (4) Nothing in Article 5, 6, 7 ,8 or 9 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of the lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
5. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One of this Order.
6. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the

hours of 8am – 9.30am on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Two of this Order.

7. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm on Monday to Saturday on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Three of this Order.
 - (a) For a longer period than 2 hours; or
 - (b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting by that vehicle.

8. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between Monday to Saturday on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Four of this Order.
 - (a) For a longer period than 40 minutes; or
 - (b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting by that vehicle.

9. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am – 6.00pm on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Five of this Order

Schedule One
(No waiting at any time)

1. Albert Road, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with King Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 45m.
2. Arleston Lane, Arleston, Telford (the north-east side) from its junction with Bennetts Bank in a south-easterly direction to a point 155m south-east of its junction with Windsor Road.
3. Arleston Lane, Arleston, Telford (the south-west side) from a point 75m south-east of the centreline of Woollam Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 74m.
4. Arleston Lane, Arleston, Telford from its junction with Watling Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 73m.
5. Arleston Lane, Arleston, Telford from its junction with Woollam Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 16m.
6. Arleston Lane, Arleston, Telford from its junction with Woollam Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 16m.
7. Constitution Hill, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with King Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 71m.
8. Constitution Hill, Wellington, Telford from its junction with King Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 44m.
9. Glebe Street, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with Victoria Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 70m.
10. Glebe Street, Wellington, Telford (Western Spur), (both sides) from its junction with Glebe Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 10m.
11. Haygate Road, Wellington, Telford (the south side from a point 15m west of its junction with Melrose Gardens for a distance of 59m.
12. King Street, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from a point 18m north-west of the centreline of Constitution Hill in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 60m.
13. King Street, Wellington, Telford (Layby), (the east side) from a point 33m south-east of the centreline of Plough Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 33m.
14. Melrose Gardens, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from the junction with Haygate Road for a distance of 15m in a south east direction.
15. Morville Drive, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with Severn Drive in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 12m.
16. School Court, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with King Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 35m.
17. Seven Drive, Wellington, Telford (the north-west side) from a point 18msouth-west of its junction with Teme Avenue in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 36m.
18. Severn Drive, Wellington, Telford (the east side) from a point 127m north-east of its junction with Morville Drive in a northerly direction to its northern extent.
19. Severn Drive, Wellington, Telford (the north-west side) from a point 15m south-west of the centreline of Morville Drive in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 30m.
20. Severn Drive, Wellington, Telford (the north-west side) from a point 40m north-east of the centreline of Morville Drive in a north easterly direction for a distance of 14m.
21. Teme Avenue, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with Severn Drive in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 14m.
22. Waterloo Road, Wellington, Telford (both sides) from its junction with Constitution Hill in an easterly direction for a distance of 34m.
23. Windsor Road, Arleston, Telford (both sides) from its junction with Arleston Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 25m.

Schedule Two
(No Waiting - Part Time 8am-9.30am)

1. King Street, Wellington, Telford (the west side) from a point 12m. south-east of its junction with Vineyard Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 54m.

Schedule Three
(Parking Places - Time Limited Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 2 Hours - No Return Within 1 Hour)

1. King Street (Layby), Wellington, Telford (the west side) from a point 23m south-east of the centreline of Plough Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 62m.

Schedule Four
(Parking Places - Time Limited Mon-Sat 40 Minutes - No Return Within 1 Hour)

1. Church Street (The Green), Wellington, Telford (the north-west side) the marked echelon bays situated from a point 30m south-west of Charlton Arms Close in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 18m.

Schedule Five
(No Waiting - Part Time 8am-6pm)

1. Church Street (The Green), Wellington, Telford (the east side) from a point 2m north of the southern boundary of No 10 Church Street in a south-westerly direction along its eastern extremity for a distance of 50m.
