## THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF TEST VALLEY ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE BOROUGH OF TEST VALLEY (VARIOUS ROADS, ANDOVER) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2008

The Borough Council of Test Valley as agent for Hampshire County Council (being the Traffic Authority) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle excepting pedal cycles to proceed in any of the following roads: Ashlawn Gardens, Millstream Close, and Watermills Close, Andover.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:
  - a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road;
  - in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunications;
  - c) for fire authority, ambulance or police purposes.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 3 March 2008 and may be cited as "The Borough of Test Valley (Various Roads, Andover) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2008".
