# THE BOROUGH OF TEST VALLEY (TOWN CENTRE, ANDOVER) APPOINTMENT OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND AND PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING ORDER 2009

The Borough Council of Test Valley as agent of Hampshire County Council (being the Traffic Authority) in exercise of its powers under the Local Government Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1976 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following order:-

#### PART I - GENERAL

### 1. In this order

"the Council" means Hampshire County Council or, as the case may be, The Borough Council of Test Valley acting as Hampshire County Council's agents

"Disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"Disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange or blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place

"Scheduled local service" has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Transport Act 1985

"Coach" means a chartered long distance single-decker bus constructed to carry more than eight seated passengers in addition to the driver

"Bus" means a public service vehicle as defined by Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981which is being used on a scheduled local service

"Hackney Carriage" has the same meaning as in the Local Government Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1976

"the Plan" means the Plan attach hereto and numbered 227552/EA/TRO/001.

- 2. Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 has effect for the purpose of defining the expression "relevant position" in this order.
- 3. The Prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

## PART II – APPOINTMENT OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND

4. The area of land shown with vertical lines on the Plan and numbered 6 in the legend on the Plan is hereby appointed to be a stand for two hackney carriages.

## PART III - AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES/LOADING BAYS

- 5. (i) Each of the parts of a road specified in schedule 1 to this order is authorised to be used subject to the following provisions of this order as a parking place/loading bay ("marked bay") for such classes of vehicles, on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part of the road in the said schedule.
  - (ii) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any marked bay.
- 6. Where in schedule 1 to this order a marked bay is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of the vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that marked bay:-
  - unless it is of the specified class (and if a disabled person's vehicle it displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority); and
  - b. unless it is positioned wholly within the marked bay; and
  - c. for longer than the maximum permitted time period.

- 7. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a marked bay:
  - a. so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
  - b. when the Council has closed that marked bay.
- 8. No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a marked bay, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the marked bay or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
- 9. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a marked bay in contravention of any of the provisions contained in article 6, article 7 or article 8 of this order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that marked bay; provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a marked bay in contravention of the provision of article 6(b) of this order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 10. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of the last preceding article of this order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
- 11. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a marked bay by virtue of article 9 of this order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

## PART IV- RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING/UNLOADING

- 12. Save as provided in articles 14 to 17 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load/unload at any time on the sides of road specified in schedule 2 to this order.
- 13. Save as provided in articles 14 to 17 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of road specified in schedule 3 to this order.

- 14. Nothing in articles 12 and 13 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road referred to in that article for so long as may be necessary:-
  - a. to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - b. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the following operations namely:-
    - the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road;
    - iii. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said sides of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunications;
  - to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - d. to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of the Post Office for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
  - e. to enable the vehicle to be used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes.

## 15. Nothing in this order shall:

- render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any side of road if that vehicle is a hackney carriage waiting at an authorised hackney carriage stand;
- b. be deemed to authorise or permit any vehicle which is not a hackney carriage to wait at an authorised hackney carriage stand;

during any period that that stand is so authorised.

## 16. Nothing in this order shall

 render it unlawful to cause or permit any bus being used in the provision of a local service to wait on any side of road if that bus is waiting at a marked bus stop;  be deemed to authorise or permit any vehicle which is not a bus being used in the provision of a local service to wait at a marked bus stop;

during any period that that bus stop is so authorised.

- 17. Nothing in this order shall:
  - a. render it unlawful to cause or permit any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to stop or wait in the disabled person's marked bay for a period not exceeding the maximum permitted
  - b. be deemed to authorise or permit any vehicle which is not a disabled person's vehicle to stop or wait in the marked bay;

during any period that that bay is so authorised.

#### PART V - REVOCATIONS AND VARIATIONS

- 18. Each of the orders specified in column 1 of schedule 4 to this order is hereby revoked to the extent specified in relation to that order in column 2 of that schedule
- 19. Each of the orders specified in column 1 of schedule 5 to this order is hereby varied to the extent specified in relation to that order in column 2 of that schedule
- 20. This order shall come into operation on the 30<sup>th</sup> July 2009 and may be cited as "The Borough of Test Valley (Town Centre, Andover) Appointment of Hackney Carriage Stand and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order 2009"
