## TEST VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

## THE BOROUGH OF TEST VALLEY (VARIOUS ROADS) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (NO. (1)) ORDER 1983

The Council of the Borough of Test Valley (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Hampshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the and may be cited as the Borough of Test Valley (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. (1)) Order 1983.
- 2. (1) In this Order -
  - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the
    Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

    "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local
    Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)

    (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975.
  - (2) For the purpose of this order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -
    - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -
      - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front

windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 2.30 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. on any day other than on Saturdays and Sundays in the lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 2.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road or on the side of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;

- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of road; or
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricty or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (e) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or side of road;
- (f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said side or any of the said lengths of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle in the lengths of roads specified in

the Schedules hereto at any time on any day.

- (3) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait in any of the lengths of road or on the side of road referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length or on the same side of road on the same day).
- 6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.

## SCHEDULE 1 (Road in Andover)

The service road at rear of the properties 45 to 57 Bridge Street.

To prohibit parking at any time in the whole length of this service road.

## SCHEDULE 2 (Roads in Andover)

(1) Vigo Road

To prohibit parking between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 2.30 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. on any day other than Saturdays and on Sundays in Vigo Road:

- (a) On its north side :-
  - (i) From its junction with Colenzo Drive in a westerly direction for a distance of 60 metres;
  - (ii) From its junction with Colenzo Drive in an easterly direction for a distance of 35 metres.
- (b) On its south side from a point opposite the boundary between 279 and 281 Vigo Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

To prohibit parking between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 2.30 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. on any day other than

(2) Colenzo Drive

on Saturdays and on Sundays in Colenzo Drive on both sides in a northerly direction from its junction with Vigo Road for a distance of 35 metres.
