## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

# THE HAMPSHIRE (MONXTON ROAD, ANDOVER) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1997

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

#### 1. (1) In this Order

"Disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982;

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a Local Authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

- (2) Regulation 2A(2),(3) and (4) of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986, as amended by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1991, has effect for the purpose of defining the expression "relevant position" in this Order.
- Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday (both days inclusive) on any of the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit
  any vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road referred to in that Article for so
  long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;

North

Between its junction with Weyhill Road and a

of that point.

Between a point 75 metres west of its junction with Weyhill Road and a point 40 metres west

of that point.

Between a point 141 metres west of its junction with Weyhill Road and its western point of termination (including the turning head), a distance of approximately 37 metres.
