ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF TEST VALLEY (VARIOUS ROADS, VALLEY PARK, CHANDLERS FORD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2008

The Borough Council of Test Valley as agent for Hampshire County Council (being the Traffic Authority) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:-

1. (a) In this order

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange or blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(b) Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 has effect for the purpose of defining the expression "relevant position" in this order.

PART I - PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, EXCEPT FOR ACCESS

- 2. Save as provided in article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads or length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any
 person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads or
 length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road or length of road;
 - b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that road or length of road, the maintenance,

improvement or reconstruction of that road or length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that road or length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunications;

c) for fire authority, ambulance or police purposes.

PART II - RESTRICTION OF WAITING

- 4. Save as provided in articles 5 and 6 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait
 - (a) at any time on any sides of road specified in schedule 2 to this order:
 - (b) between the hours of 800 a.m. and 400 p.m. from Monday to Friday (both days inclusive) on any sides of road specified in schedule 3 to this order.
- 5. Nothing in article 4 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any sides of road referred to in that article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the following operations namely:-
 - (i) building or demolition;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road:
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said sides of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunication;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties:
 - (e) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road;

- (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road for so long as is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
- (g) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes.
- 6. Nothing in article 4 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any sides of road referred to for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road on the same day).
- 7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

PART III - REVOCATIONS

- 8. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Valley Park, Chandlers Ford)
 (Prohibition of Waiting and Driving) Order 2000 and the Hampshire
 (Various Roads, Valley Park, Chandlers Ford) (Prohibition of Waiting
 and Driving) Order 2000 (Variation) Order 2003 are hereby revoked in
 their entirety.
- 8. This order shall come into operation on the 31 October 2008 and may be cited as "The Borough of Test Valley (Various Roads, Valley Park, Chandlers Ford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Prohibition of Driving) Order 2008".
