THE HAMPSHIRE (LITTLE ANN)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1976

The Hampshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Hampshire hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ^{9th} day of February 1976 and may be cited as "The Hampshire (Little Ann) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1976."

2.(1) In this Order

"Disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975;

"Disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1975;

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631; 1970), coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

"Relevant position" means

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen;

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on those lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

(b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;

(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.

5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same lengths of road).
6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by any other enactment.
