## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, WATFORD RURAL) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (Consolidation) ORDER 2001

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

 This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Watford Rural) (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2001" and shall come into operation on Monday 8 October 2001.

## 2. In this Order

"Prohibited area" means any area of road which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with Diags 1025.1 and 1025.3 supplemented by signs to Diag 974 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No.4631 : 1970), coloured orange or blue, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and "relevant position" means

A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; and
- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

- A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:
  - a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or
  - b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

- iii) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if:
  - a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
  - b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of roads in Wátford Rural specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturday in the lengths of roads in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 16 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for a period in excess of 30 minutes with no return in the next two hours between the hours of 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturday in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturday in the lengths of roads in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 4 of this Order.
- 7. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.00 pm on Moday to Saturday in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.
- 8. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 10.00 am on Moday to Saturday in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 6 of this Order.
- 9. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm on Moday to Friday in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 7 of this Order.
- 10. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 15 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm on Moday to Friday in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 8 of this Order.

- 11. Save as provided in Article 14 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle to wait in the prohibited area between the hours of 7.00 am to 7.00 pm in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 9 of this Order.
- 12. Save as provided in Articles 13 and 16 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a disabled person's vehicle displaying vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 10 of this Order.
- 13. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :-
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
  - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
  - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (v) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953,
- (e) loading or unloading goods to or from premises in the said lengths of roads.
- 14. Nothing in Article 12 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :-
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
    - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or

electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984:

(v) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- 14. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait in the lengths of roads in Watford Rural specified in Schedules 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order for a period of 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- 15. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait at any time in the length of road in Watford Rural specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 16. The provisions of the following Traffic Regulation Orders and other Orders not referred to below insofar as they relate to lengths of roads detailed in this Consolidation Order are hereby revoked:
  - a) Three Rivers (Various Roads, Carpenders Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) and (Amendment) Order 1990.
  - b) Three Rivers (The Parade and Bridlington Road, South Oxhey) (Parking Bays for the disabled) Order 1986.
  - c) Three Rivers (Various Roads, South Oxhey) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976.
  - d) Three Rivers (Station Approach, South Oxhey) (Prohibition and Restriction of waiting) Order 1976.
  - e) Three Rivers (Station Approach, South Oxhey) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977.
  - f) The County of Hertford (Various Streets, Carpenders Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967.
  - g) The London Traffic (Prohibition of Waiting) (Abbots Langley and Watford Rural, Watford) Regulations 1965.
  - h) The Hertfordshire (Bridlington Road, South Oxhey, Watford Rural) (Revocation of Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2000.
  - i) Three Rivers (Rear Service Roads, South Oxhey) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984.
  - j) The County of Hertford (Various Roads, Carpenders Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970.
  - k) Three Rivers (Various Roads, Carpenders Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975.
  - 1) The Hertfordshire (Gosforth Lane, South Oxhey, Watford Rural) (Prohibition of waiting) Order 1997.
- 17. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 18. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
