**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, CROXLEY GREEN)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (Consolidation) ORDER 2001**

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Croxley Green) (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2001" and shall come into operation on Monday 8 October 2001.

2. In this Order

"Prohibited area" means any area of road which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with Diags 1025.1 and 1025.3 supplemented by signs to Diag 974 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No.4631 : 1970), coloured orange or blue, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and "relevant position" means

i) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; and
- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

ii) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or
- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

iii) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
- b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

- 3. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 12 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of roads in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 11 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to at any time, including for loading and unloading in the length of road in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 12 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturday in the lengths of roads in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 12 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturday in the length of road in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 4 of this Order.
- 7. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 13 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on Monday to Saturday for a period in excess of 20 minutes return prohibited within the next two hours in the length of road in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.
- 8. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 13 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on Monday to Saturday for a period in excess of 1 hour return prohibited within the next two hours in the lengths of roads in Croxley Green specified in Schedule 6 of this Order.
- 9. Save as provided in Article 11 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle to wait in the prohibited areas between the hours of 7.00 am to 12.00 midnight in the lengths of Croxley Green specified in Schedule 6 of this Order.

10. Nothing in Articles 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (v) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
- (e) loading or unloading goods to or from premises in the said lengths of roads.

11. Nothing in Articles 4 and 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :-

- (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- (b) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

12. Nothing in Articles 3, 5, and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait in the lengths of roads in Croxley Green specified in Schedules 1, 3 and 4 of this Order for a period of 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
13. Nothing in Articles 7 and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait at any time in the lengths of roads in Croxley Green specified in Schedules 5 and 6 of this Order.
14. The provisions of the following Traffic Regulation Orders and other Orders not referred to below insofar as they relate to lengths of roads detailed in this Consolidation Order are hereby revoked:-
- Three Rivers (New Road and York Road, Croxley Green) (Prohibition and restriction of Waiting) Order 1991.
 - The Rickmansworth (New Road) (Restriction of Waiting) (No1) Order 1972.
 - The Three Rivers (New Road, Croxley Green) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) Order 1980.
 - The Three Rivers (New Road) Restriction of Waiting) (No2) Order 1972.
 - The Rickmansworth (Bus Stop) (Clearway) Order 1972.
 - The Rickmansworth (Barton Way and New Road Car Park Access Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972.
 - Three Rivers (Frankland Road (park) Croxley Green) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984.
 - The Rickmansworth (Hazelwood Drive and Watford Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.
 - The Rickmansworth Winton Drive, Winton Crescent and Springfield close) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969.
 - Three Rivers (Watford Road) (part) and Winton Approach (part) Croxley Green) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983.
 - The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Croxley Green) (Prohibition and restriction of Waiting, Bus Stop and Clearway) Order 2000.
 - The Hertfordshire (New Road and adjoining Roads, Croxley Green, Watford) (Prohibition and restriction of Waiting, parking places and Bus Stop clearway) Order 2000.
15. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
16. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

A412 Watford Road	North	From a point approximately 18 metres west of its junction with New Road eastwards for approximately 18 metres to its junction with New Road
A412 Watford Road	South East / South	From a point approximately 5 metres north of its junction with Hazelwood Road, southwards and south westwards for a distance of approximately 214 metres to the termination markings of the pedestrian crossing
Barton Way	Both	From its junction with New Road, northwards for a distance of approximately 17 metres

Community Way	Both	From its junction with Barton Way, westwards for a distance of approximately 122 metres
Dickinson Square	Both	From its junction with New Road, southwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres
Frankland Road	West	From its junction with A412 Watford Road southwards for a distance of approximately 11 metres
Frankland Road	East	From its junction with A412 Watford Road southwards for a distance of approximately 6 metres
Hazelwood Road	South	From its junction with A412 Watford Road eastwards for a distance of approximately 10 metres
Hazelwood Road	North	From its junction with A412 Watford Road eastwards for a distance of approximately 11 metres
New Road	South West	From its junction with A412 Watford Road north westwards for a distance of approximately 12 metres
New Road	North East	From its junction with A412 Watford Road north westwards for a distance of approximately 17 metres
New Road	North	From a point approximately 14 metres east of its junction with Barton Way, westwards for a distance of approximately 33.5 metres to a point approximately 12 metres west of its junction with Barton Way
New Road	North	From the western side of its junction with Tussauds Close, eastwards for a distance of approximately 41 metres
New Road	South	From a point approximately 4.5 metres west of its junction with Dickinson Square eastwards for a distance of approximately 45 metres
New Road	South	From a point approximately 15 metres west of its junction with York Road, eastwards for a distance of approximately 37 metres
New Road	South	From a point approximately 136 metres east of its junction with Dickinson Square, eastwards for a distance of approximately 36 metres, to a point at the eastern boundary of 206 New Road
Service Road	North	From its junction with A412 Watford Road south-westwards to its junction with Frankland Road
Winton Approach	East	From its junction with Winton Drive southwards to its junction with A412 Watford Road
Winton Approach	West	From its junction with the A412 Watford Road northwards for approximately 6 metres.
Winton Drive	North West	From its junction with A412 Watford Road north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 18 metres
York Road	Both	From its junction with New Road southwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres

Springfield Close	North	From its junction with Winton Drive westwards for a distance of approximately 27.5 metres
Springfield Close	South	From its junction with Winton Drive westwards for a distance of approximately 31 metres
Winton Crescent (Southern Leg)	Both	From its junction with Winton Drive westwards for a distance of approximately 17.5 metres
Winton Drive	North West	From a point approximately 18 metres north east of its junction with A412 Watford Road, north eastwards to a point approximately 21 metres north east of its junction with Winton Crescent, a distance of approximately 239 metres
Winton Drive	South East	From a point approximately 27 metres north east of its junction with A412 Watford Road north eastwards to a point approximately 21 metres north east of its junction with Winton Crescent, a distance of approximately 218 metres
