**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, MOOR PARK, RICKMANSWORTH)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (Consolidation) ORDER 2001**

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Moor Park, Rickmansworth) (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2001" and shall come into operation on Monday 8 October 2001.

2. In this Order

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No.4631 : 1970), coloured orange or blue, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and "relevant position" means

i) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; and
- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

ii) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or
- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

iii) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if:-

- a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
- b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

3. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in lengths of roads in Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm on Monday to Saturday in the lengths of roads in Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
5. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on Monday to Friday in the lengths of Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.
6. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10.00 am to 12 noon and 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm on Monday to Friday in the lengths of Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 4 of this Order.
7. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a officer authorised by Three Rivers District Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on Monday to Saturday for a period in excess of 75 minutes return prohibited within the next 90 minutes, in lengths of roads in Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.
8. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable :
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (v) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
 - (e) loading or unloading goods to or from premises in that length of road.

9. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait in the lengths of roads in Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 1 of this Order for a period of 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
10. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait in the lengths of roads in Rickmansworth specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.
11. The provisions of the following Traffic Regulation Orders and other Orders not referred to below insofar as they relate to lengths of roads detailed in this Consolidation Order are hereby revoked:-
 - a) The Hertfordshire (North Approach, South Approach, Main Avenue and Wolsey Road, Moor Park, Rickmansworth) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1999.
 - b) Three Rivers (Main Avenue, junction between Wolsey Road and North Approach, Moor Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1986.
 - c) Three Rivers (Various Roads, Moor Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980.
 - d) Three Rivers (Main Avenue (part) and Wolsey Road (part) Moor Park) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984.
 - e) Three Rivers (Various Roads, Moor Park) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1992.
12. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
13. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Schedule 1: No Waiting – At Any Time.

Street Name	Side of Road	Location
Main Avenue	North	From its junction with North Approach westwards for a distance of approximately 8 metres
Main Avenue	North	From a point approximately 8 metres east of its junction with Wolsey Road, westwards to a point approximately 43 metres west of its junction with Wolsey Road, a distance of approximately 60 metres
Main Avenue	South	From a point approximately 9 metres east of its junction with Wolsey Road, westwards to a point approximately 46 metres west of its junction with Wolsey Road, a distance of approximately 63 metres
Main Avenue	South	From its junction with South Approach, westwards for a distance of approximately 6 metres
Main Avenue	North	From its junction with Pembroke Road, eastwards for approximately 14.5 metres
Main Avenue	South	From its junction with Pembroke Road, eastwards for approximately 19.5 metres
Main Avenue, Central Island	Both	From its junction with North Approach, westwards to its junction with Wolsey Road, a distance of approximately 90 metres
North Approach	West	From its junction with Main Avenue northwards to its junction with Sandy Lodge Road, a distance of approximately 286 metres
North Approach	East	From its junction with Main Avenue, northwards for a distance of approximately 29 metres
North Approach	East	From its junction with Sandy Lodge Road, southwards for a distance of approximately 14 metres
Pembroke Road	East	From a point approximately 20 metres north-east of its junction with Main Avenue south-westwards to a point approximately 31 metres south-west of its junction with Main Avenue
South Approach	West	From its junction with Main Avenue, southwards for a distance of approximately 79.5 metres, to a point approximately 13 metres south of its junction with Westbury Road
South Approach	East	From its junction with Main Avenue, southwards for a distance of approximately 35 metres
Wolsey Road	East	From a point approximately 67 metres north of its junction with Main Avenue southwards to a point approximately 79 metres south of its junction with Main Avenue
Wolsey Road	West	From a point approximately 71 metres north of its junction with Main Avenue southwards to a point approximately 83 metres south of its junction with Main Avenue

Schedule 2: No Waiting – Monday to Saturday – 1.00pm to 2.00pm.

Street Name	Side of Road	Location
Main Avenue	South	From a point approximately 6 metres west of its junction with South Approach westwards for a distance of approximately 80 metres to a point approximately 9 metres east of its junction with Wolsey Road

Schedule 3: No waiting – Monday to Friday – 8.30am to 5.30pm.

Street Name	Side of Road	Location
Pembroke Access Road (Leading to Golf Club)	Both	From its junction with Pembroke Road, south-westwards for approximately 10 metres.
Pembroke Road / Astons Road.	East	From a point approximately 31 metres south-west of its junction with Main Avenue, southwards for a distance of approximately 65 metres to a point approximately 9 metres south of the northern boundary of 1 Astons Road.
Pembroke Road / Astons Road.	West	From a point approximately 13 metres north east of its junction with Main Avenue (northern kerb line) southwards for a distance of approximately 127 metres to a point approximately 9 metres south of the northern boundary of 1 Astons Road.
Russell Road	Both	From its junction with Wolsey Road westwards for a distance of approximately 18 metres
Wolsey Road	East	From a point approximately 67 metres north of its junction with Main Avenue, northwards for a distance of approximately 226 metres to a point adjacent to the northern boundary of 1 Wolsey Road.
Wolsey Road	East	From a point approximately 79 metres south of its junction with Main Avenue, southwards for a distance of approximately 82 metres, to a point approximately 12 metres south of its junction with Russell Road
Wolsey Road	West	From a point approximately 71 metres north of its junction with Main Avenue northwards for a distance of approximately 210 metres to its junction with Pembroke Road
Wolsey Road	West	From a point approximately 83 metres south of its junction with Main Avenue southwards for a distance of approximately 84 metres, to a point approximately 12 metres south of its junction with Russell Road

Schedule 4 : No Waiting – Monday to Friday – 10.00am to 12 noon and 2.30pm to 4.30pm.

Street Name	Side of Road	Location
Main Avenue	North	From a point approximately 43 metres west of its junction with Wolsey Road, westwards for a distance of approximately 245 metres, to a point approximately 14.5 metres east of its junction with Pembroke Road
Main Avenue	South	From a point approximately 46 metres west of its junction with Wolsey Road, westwards for a distance of approximately 243 metres to a point approximately 19.5 metres east of its junction with Pembroke Road
North Approach	East	From a point approximately 29 metres north of its junction with Main Avenue northwards to a point approximately 14 metres south of its junction with Sandy Lodge Road, a distance of approximately 227 metres
South Approach	East	From a point approximately 35 metres south of its junction with Main Avenue, southwards to a point approximately 13 metres south of its junction with Westbury Road, a distance of approximately 745 metres.

Schedule 5: No Waiting – Monday to Saturday – 8.30am to 5.30pm.**Waiting limited to 75 minutes no return within 90 minutes.**

Street Name	Side of Road	Location
Main Avenue	North	From a point approximately 8 metres west of its junction with North Approach, westwards for a distance of approximately 65 metres to a point approximately 22 metres east of its junction with Wolsey Road
Main Avenue	West	The western section of Main Avenue roundabout, opposite the southern most corner of Park Mansions, from a point opposite and approximately 26 metres west of the most western boundary of 2 Park Mansions, southwards for approximately 15 metres
