THE THREE RIVERS (VARIOUS ROADS, OUTER AREA, CHORLEYWOOD) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT N°1) ORDER 2003

The Three Rivers District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 3, 4, 32, 35 and 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ("the Act") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Three Rivers (Various Roads, Outer Area, Chorleywood) (Parking Places) (Amendment No.1) Order 2003" and shall come into operation on 10th May 2004.
- 2. The amendments to The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Outer Area, Chorleywood) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2001 are referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. For regulations relating to Residents' Permits refer to Part III, Section 1 – Residents' Permits, of the Chorleywood Central Area (Parking Places) Order 2001, copy of which is attached.

SCHEDULE 1 (new schedule)

Part 1: Lengths of roads in Chorleywood Outer Area – Residents' permit parking Monday to Friday 11 am to 12 noon:

Street Name	Side of Street	Location
South Road	South	Between points approximately 15 metres and 80 metres east of its junction with Hillside Road, a distance of approximately 65 metres.
South Road	South	Between points approximately 116 metres and 178 metres east of its junction with Hillside Road, a distance of approximately 62 metres.

Berks Hill	South	Between points approximately 57 metres and 90 metres east of its junction with Hillside Road, a distance of approximately 33 metres.
Berks Hill	South	Between points approximately 114 metres and 156 metres east of its junction with Hillside Road, a distance of approximately 42 metres.
Quickley Lane	North	Between points 30 metres and 130 metres west of its junction with Lower Road, a distance of approximately 100 metres.

Part 2: Scale of Charges:

- (a) In respect of a first residents' permit which shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from the date on which the residents' permit first becomes valid, twenty pounds.
- (b) In respect of any one first residents' permit or second residents' permit issued to a disabled person holding a valid disabled person's badge issued by any Local Authority, free of charge.
