THE THREE RIVERS DISTRICT COUNCIL (DULWICH WAY, CROXLEY GREEN) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2005

The Three Rivers District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") makes this Road Traffic Regulation Order pursuant to arrangements under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1 to 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 February 2005 and may be cited as "The Three Rivers District Council (Dulwich Way, Croxley Green) (Prohibition of Stopping) Order 2005".
- 2. In this Order

'the 1984 Act' means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a parking attendant on duty or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday (inclusive) in the length of Dulwich Way, Croxley Green as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the length of road specified in the Schedule in any case where the person in control of the vehicle:-
 - (a) is required by law to stop;
 - (b) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident; or
 - (c) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his/her control.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of any Act of Parliament.
- 6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
