ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (STATION APPROACH, STATION ROAD and HOMESTEAD ROAD, RICKMANSWORTH) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2007

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Station Approach, Station Road and Homestead Road, Rickmansworth) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday 14 September 2009.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3, 4, and 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of Station Approach, Station Road and Homestead Road, Rickmansworth as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of -
 - (i) a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Three Rivers District Council.
 - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
 - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
 - (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to

render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary –

- (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
- (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
 - (2) In this Article -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

- 6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULElengths of road in Rickmansworth – no waiting at any time

Station Approach / Station Road (south west & west sides)	from a point 3 metres south of a point in line with the north facing wall of the Metropolitan Line overbridge northwards and north westwards for approximately 12.5 metres into Station Approach.
Station Road (both sides)	from a point 2 metres south of a point in line with the south facing wall of the Metropolitian Line overbridge southwards for 3.5 metres.
Station Approach /Homestead Road (splitter island) (south east side)	from its junction with its northern kerbline to its junction with its south western kerbline a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
Homestead Road (a) (north side)	from a point 7.5 metres west of its junction with the east kerbline of the exit road from Drake House westwards for 6.5 metres.
(b)	from its junction with the east kerbline of the exit road from Drake House eastwards for 35.5 metres.
(south east side)	from its junction with the west kerbline of the Homestead Road Bus Service Road (eastern end) westwards for 33 metres to its junction with the east kerbline of the Homestead Road Bus Service Road (western end).
(east side) (a)	from its junction with the north kerbline of the entrance road into Rickmansworth Station car park northwards for 5 metres.

(b) from its junction with the north kerbline of the entrance road into

Waitrose car park northwards for 7 metres.

(c) from its junction with the north kerbline of the exit road from Waitrose car park northwards for 4.5 metres.

Station Road / Homestead Road (east & south sides) from a point 2.5 metres south of a point in line with the north facing wall of The Metropolitan Line overbridge northwards and eastwards for approximately 24 metres to its junction with the south kerbline of the Homestead Road Bus Service Road (western end).

Homestead Road (Bus Service Road) (south side) from its junction with the south kerbline of Homestead Road south eastwards for 10 metres.

(west side)

from its junction with the south east kerbline of Homestead Road southwards for 2 metres.

(east side)

from its junction with the south kerbline of the entrance to Rickmansworth Station car park southwards for 5.5 metres.

from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road north eastwards for 4 metres.

Rickmansworth Station car park exit (both sides) from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road south eastwards for 4 metres

Waitrose car park Entrance (south east side) from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road north eastwards for 8.5 metres.

(north west side)

from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road north eastwards

for 4.5 metres.

Waitrose car park exit (south side)

from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road eastwards for 4 metres.

Waitrose car park exit (north side)

from its junction with the east kerbline of Homestead Road south

eastwards for 8 metres.
