THE THREE RIVERS (VARIOUS ROADS, CHORLEYWOOD OUTER AREA) (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT No. 1) (VARIOUS ROADS INCLUDING CAPELL WAY AND SHIRE LANE) ORDER 2012

The Three Rivers District Council ("the Council"), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Three Rivers (Various Roads, Chorleywood Outer Area) (Parking Places) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 1) (Various Roads Including Capell Way and Shire Lane) Order 2012 [this order] and shall amend the Three Rivers (Various Roads, Chorleywood Outer Area) (Parking Places) Order 2006 [that order or the order of 2006] and shall come into operation on 1st October 2012.
- 2. The order of 2006 shall have effect as though:
 - a)the details entered in columns, 2 and 3, referring to the Shire Lane service road, at Schedule 1 of that order were substituted by those in columns 2 and 3, referring to the Shire Lane Service Road, at Schedule 1 of this order.
 - b)at Schedule 2 of that order there were added the rows at Schedule 2 of this order.
 - c) Schedule 2A of this order were added to that order.
 - d)at Schedule 4 of that order there were added the rows at Schedule 4 of this order.
 - e)Schedule 5 of that order were substituted by Schedule 5 of this order.
 - f) Schedule 6 of this order were added to that order.
 - g)in the second line of paragraph (3) of article 21 of that order the words "paragraph (5) of this article" were substituted by the words "schedule 6 of this order".
 - h)paragraph (5) of article 21 of that order were omitted.

3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

- * <u>Blue Badge Holders</u> For a household within a permit area where one of the residents is a blue badge holder the first permit shall be free of charge. Any second permit issued will be charged as specified above.
- ** <u>Senior Citizens</u> For Senior Citizens 12 month resident's visitor permits shall be discounted by 50%.
- ** <u>Visitor permits</u> By a notice served on 4th March 2011 the charge for 12 month resident's visitor permits shall be increased in price from £25 to £30 on 25th March 2013.
