THE HERTFORDSHIRE (A41 WATFORD ROAD, ABBOTS LANGLEY, A41 HEMPSTEAD ROAD, HUNTON BRIDGE ROUNDABOUT, A41 NORTH WESTERN AVENUE AND GADE SIDE, WATFORD) (CLEARWAY) ORDER 2006

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

 This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (A41 Watford Road, Abbots Langley, A41 Hempstead Road, Hunton Bridge Roundabout, A41 North Western Avenue and Gade Side, Watford) (Clearway) Order 2006" and shall come into operation on Monday 9 October 2006.

2. In this Order:

"made up carriageway" has the meaning as given in the Highways Act 1980 but does not include lay-bys.

"hard shoulder" means any carriageway adjacent to the main carriageway but does not include lay-bys.

"verge" means any part of a road which is not a carriageway contained within the limits of the boundary fence but does not include lay-bys.

- 3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle stop or wait at any time on those lengths of made up carriageway, hard shoulder and verge on A41 Watford Road, Abbots Langley, A41 Hempstead Road, Hunton Bridge Roundabout, A41 North Western Avenue and Gade Side, Watford specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4(1) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
 - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or

- (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE

length of A41 Watford Road, Abbots Langley, A41 Hempstead Road, Hunton Bridge
Roundabout, A41 North Western Avenue and Gade Side, Watford –
no stopping or waiting at any time

A41 Watford Road Roundabout for its entire circulatory length of approximately 460 metres. (at j/w J20 M25)

A41 Watford Road/ Hempstead Road from its junction with M25 junction 20 south eastwards for approximately 1800 metres to its junction with Hunton Bridge Roundabout.

Hunton Bridge Roundabout

for its entire circulatory length of approximately 560 metres.

A41 North Western Avenue/ Gade Side from its junction with Hunton Bridge Roundabout eastwards for approximately 1730 metres to a point 6 metres west of its junction with the west kerbline of Rushton Avenue, including the entire lengths of the eastbound on/off slip roads and westbound on/off slip roads for Leavesden Green Roundabout.
