THE THREE RIVERS (RESTRICTION OF WAITING, VARIOUS ROADS) ORDER 2015 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2015

The Three Rivers District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 3 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and citation

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Three Rivers (Restriction of Waiting, Various Roads) Order 2015 (Amendment No.1) Order 2015 (hereinafter referred to as "this Order") and shall come into operation on 10 August 2015 and shall amend The Three Rivers (Restriction of Waiting, Various Roads) Order 2015 (hereinafter referred to as "the order of 2015".
- 2. There shall be inserted into the order of 2015 the following items within the schedule indicated:

Schedule 1: No waiting at any time

Item no.	Street name	Side of street	Location
13	Church Lane and Shepherds Lane, Rickmansworth	North	From a the mutual property boundary of no.s 88 and 90 Church Lane westwards and north-westwards to the mutual property boundary of no. 94 Church Lane and no. 2 Shepherds Lane.
14	Church Lane and Shepherds Lane, Rickmansworth	South	From a the mutual property boundary of no.s 153 and 155 Church Lane westwards and north-westwards to a point 4 metres south-east of a point in line with the mutual property boundary of no. 94 Church Lane and no. 2 Shepherds Lane.

3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
