Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

NOTICE is given that the Kent County Council acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 5, 32, 45, 46, 47 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to said Act, hereby make the following Order:

The effect of the named Order will introduce or amend existing waiting restrictions (in this part of the notice DYL means double yellow lines) – No waiting at any time on the following length of roads in Ditton, Tonbridge & Malling.

THE STREAM – DYL - (1) On the west side extend the existing 15 metres of DYLs from the junction with New Road to a point in line with the northwest boundary of 43 The Stream. (2) On the northwest side extend the existing 15 metres of DYLs from the junction with New Road to a point in line and opposite the southern boundary of 44 The Stream.

The Order was made on 20 June 2024 and its provisions will come into effect on 21 June 2024.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be examined at Kroner House, Eurogate Business Park, Ashford, Kent TN24 8XU by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 21 June 2024 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as the “TMA 2004”), and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order may be cited as “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tonbridge and Malling) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.60 Order 2024” (“this Order”) and shall come into operation on 21st day of June 2024.

“The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tonbridge & Malling) (Waiting Restrictions & On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011” (“the Consolidation Order”) shall be modified and have effect as per outlined in the Schedule of this Order.
