THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, EAST MALLING AND LARKFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 1999

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

Temporary Modification

1. The Order named in Schedule 1 to this Order is temporarily modified as described therein.

Experimental Prohibition of Waiting

- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle:
 - a. if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any roadworks or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports;
 - b. to be used by a Local Authority or Water Authority in exercise of statutory powers; or
 - c. to be used for Police, Ambulance or Fire Brigade purposes.
- 4. This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Order 1999" and shall come into operation on the 15th day of February 1999 for a period not exceeding 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1

(Order to be temporarily modified)

"The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1991" is hereby amended by the deletion of items 6(c) and 6(d) from Part 1 of the First Schedule.

SCHEDULE 2

(No Waiting at any time)

1. New Hythe Lane:

- a. on its south east side from a point in line with the northern boundary of No. 432 New Hythe Lane generally north eastwards to a point 32 metres north east of its junction with Westmead; and
- b. on its north west side from a point 14 metres north east of its junction with Leybourne Way north eastwards to a point 32 metres north east of its junction with Westmead.
- 2. New Hythe Lane (old section) on both sides from its junction with Westmead eastwards for 9.5 metres.
- 3. Westmead on both sides, from its junction with New Hythe Lane northwards for 68.5 metres.
