THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, EAST MAILING
AND LARKFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND RESTRICTION
LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 1996

The Kent County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 , hereby makes the following Order:-

1. "The Kent County Council (Church Walk and The Grange, East MaIling) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984", is hereby revoked
2. "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Mailing and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1991", shall have effect as though the following lengths of road were included in Part $I$ of the First Schedule thereto:-
3. High Street, East MaIling :-
a) on the west side from its junction with Mill street in a southerly direction to its junction with Chapel Street;
b) on the east side:-
i) from its junction with Church Walk to the boundary of Nos 11/13 High Street;
ii) from a point south of the layby north of the railway bridge to its junction with Chapel Street.
4. Chapel Street, East MaIling:-
a) on the west side from its junction with High Street to the boundary of Nos $10 / 12$ Chapel Street; and
b) on the east side from its junction with High Street to the northern boundary of No 1 Chapel Street.
5. Church Walk, East Mailing:-
a) on the north side from its junction with New Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres; and
b) on the south side from its junction with High Street to the western boundary wall of St James Church.
6. Rocks Road, East MaIling, on both sides, from its junction with Chapel Street in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
7. The Grange, East MaIling from its junction with Church Walk in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
