THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, EAST MALLING AND LARKFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND RESTRICTION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 1992

The Kent County Council in exercise of its powers of the said County Council under Sections I (1), (2), (3), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on Nine November 1992 and may be cited as the "Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) (Variation No. 1) Order 1992."
2. Except where the context admits any reference to a Schedule is a reference to a Schedule to this Order.
3. In this Order the expression "Order of 1991" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1991".
4. The Order of 1991 is hereby varied as follows:
 - (a) The Order of 1991 shall have effect as though the following length of road was omitted from the Second Schedule (No Waiting between 8.30 a.m and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday) thereto.

<u>Road</u>	<u>Length of Road</u>
Martin Square	from a point opposite the Southern boundary of No. 20 Martin Square in a Northerly direction to a point opposite the Northern boundary of No. 36 Martin Square.

- (b) The Order of 1991 shall have effect as though the following lengths of roads were included in Part I of the First Schedule (No Waiting At Any Time) thereto.

<u>Road</u>	<u>Length of Road</u>
Martin Square	<u>Both Sides</u> - from a point 3 metres south of the southern boundary of Nos. 8/10 Martin Square (entrance to St. Martins Old Peoples' Home) to the Magpie Close junction.

<u>Road</u>	<u>Length of Road</u>
Magpie Close	<p><u>East Side</u> - for distance of 10 metres south from the junction with Martin Square.</p> <p><u>West Side</u> - from a point 10 metres south of the junction with Kingfisher Road northwards to the junction with Kingfisher Road.</p> <p><u>East Side</u> - from the junction with Martin Square to the junction with Kingfisher Road.</p>
Kingfisher Road	<p><u>South Side</u> - for a distance of 15 metres either side of the Magpie Close junction.</p>

(c) The Order of 1991 shall have effect as though the following Articles were included.

"2A Save as provided by Article 3A of this Order no person except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto."

"3A. Nothing in Article 2A this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto if the vehicle is:-

(a) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road or of any sewer or main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraphic Act 1878;

(b) is being used in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(c) is being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or civil defence purposes;

(d) The Order of 1991 shall have effect as though it included a "Fourth Schedule" entitled - "Prohibition of All Vehicular Traffic" and such Schedule included the following length of road.

between a point adjacent to the Southern flank wall of Nos. 8 to 18 Martin Square for a distance of 70 metres northwards.

5. The following Order is hereby revoked.

"The County Council of Kent (Martin Square, Larkfield) (One-Way) Order 1968."

6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and the Act of 1984 as amended as aforesaid or by or under any other enactments.
