# PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND RESTRICTION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 1991

The Kent County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1990" is hereby revoked.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Gonstable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait:-
  - (a) in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order;
  - (b) between the hours of 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order;
  - (c) between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order:
    - ( i) for a longer period than 20 minutes; or
    - (ii) if a period of less than 40 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; except that no vehicle shall wait for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded between the hours of 8.00 am and 9.30 am, or between the hours of 4.30 pm and 6.00 pm in either of the lengths of road specified in Part II of the First Schedule to this Order.;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any buildings operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any roadworks or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports;

8. This Order shall come into operation on the Ninth day of December 1991 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, East Malling and Larkfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1991".

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

#### PART 1

(No waiting at any time)

# Lengths of Road in the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

- 1. Blacklands on the west side from the centre of its junction with Chapman Way in a southerly direction for a distance of 50 metres.
- 2. Chapman Way on the south side from the centre of its junction with Blacklands in a westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- 3. Kingfisher Road:
  - a) from the centre of its junction with Lunsford Lane for a distance of 24 metres in an easterly direction; and
  - b) from its junction with New Hythe Lane for a distance of  $20\ \text{metres}$  in a westerly direction.
- 4. Larkfield Road: -
  - (a) on the east side, from its junction with London Road, in a northerly direction to a point 1 metre north of the south wall of the National Westminster Bank; and
  - (b) on the west side, from its junction with London Road, in a northerly direction to a point in line with the south wall of 38 Larkfield Road.
- 5. London Road (A20):-

#### PART II

(No Waiting at any time - no loading or unloading between 8.00 am and 9.30 am and between 4.30 pm and 6.00 pm)

#### Lengths of Road in the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

London Road (A20):-

- (a) on the north side between points 95 metres east and 140 metres west of its junction with New Hythe Lane:
- (b) on the south side between points 95 metres east and 92 metres west of its junction with New Hythe Lane.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE

(No Waiting between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays)

## Length of Road in the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

- (a) Martin Square from a point opposite the southern boundary of Number 20 Martin Square in a northerly direction to a point opposite the northern boundary of Number 36 Martin Square.
- (b) London Road (A20):-

on the south side from a point opposite the party wall of Numbers 717/719 London Road for a distance of 148 metres in an easterly direction.

(c) Larkfield Road: -

on the west side from a point in line with the south wall of No. 38 Larkfield Road in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Larkfield Close.

#### THIRD SCHEDULE

(Waiting prohibited for longer than 20 minutes in any 1 hour between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays)

## Lengths of Road in the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

London Road (A20) on the north side from a point opposite its junction with Walnut Tree Court for a distance of 43 metres in an easterly direction.
