

The Kent County Council (Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council Street Parking Places (Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1987) (Variation No.3) Order 1995

The Kent County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said county council under sections 32, 35 and 124(1) of, and Part IV of schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council Street Parking Places (Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1987) (Variation No.3) Order 1995.
 - (2) This Order shall come into operation on the 11 day of December 1995.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (2) In this Order, the expression "the Order of 1987" means the Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council Street Parking Places (Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1987.

Variation of Order of 1987

- 3. The Order of 1987 shall have effect as though:
 - (a) the length of road specified as a parking place in schedule 1 to this Order was included in schedule 1 to the Order of 1987; and
 - (b) the length of road specified as a parking place in schedule 2 to this Order was omitted from schedule 2 to the Order of 1987.

Saving

4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation from, any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or the Act of 1987 or by or under any other enactment.
