THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, TONBRIDGE) (VARIATION OF BOROUGH OF TONBRIDGE AND MALLING 1986 CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC ORDER) (VARIATION No. 40) ORDER, 1997

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order shall come into operation on the 21st day of April, 1997, and may be cited As "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tonbridge) (Variation of Borough of Tonbridge and Malling 1986 Consolidated Traffic Order) (Variation No. 40) Order, 1997"

A. The Borough of Tonbridge and Malling (Consolidation of Traffic Orders) (Various Roads, Tonbridge and Hildenborough) Order 1986 shall have effect as though in the Articles to the Order:

(a) Article 16 shall be renumbered Article 1;

(b) for Articles 1 to 15 and 17 to 20 there shall be substituted the following:

PART A General

INTERPRETATION

2 (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"the Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the Council" means the Kent County Council, as Traffic Authority;

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods include checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"disabled person" and "disabled person's badge" have the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons' (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge and which is a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 to be included in an order under the 1984 Act, has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or, as the case may be, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"goods" includes postal packets of any description;

PART A GENERAL

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description or a trailer so constructed or adapted;

"highway manager" means such person as shall be approved by Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council to manage the Highway Management Unit

"Highway Management Unit" means the Highway Management Unit established by Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council to carry out highway activities under the Kent Highways partnership agreement between Kent County Council, as traffic authority, and Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council;

"invalid carriage" means a mechanically propelled vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person;

"junction" means the junction of the respective kerb lines of the roads referred to and, where appropriate, measurements shall be taken from the point of intersection of the respective kerb lines as projected;

"licensed taxi" has the same meaning as in the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

"motor vehicle" means a motor car or a motor cycle and "motor car" and " motor cycle" have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"owner", in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

"parking attendant" has the same meaning as in section 63A of the Act of 1984;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

"parking place" means an area on a highway designated or authorised and described as a parking place by any of the various Articles or Schedules of this Order;

"parking space" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

"public passenger vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"relevant position" means:-

- 1 In the case of a Disabled Person's Badge
 - (a) a vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from the outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

(b) a vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if: -

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

(c) In the case of any other badge or permit as follows: -

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge or permit is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge or permit is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

"resident" means a person whose usual residence is at premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of a street described in Part 3 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order, and the meaning of "resident" shall also include any person whose usual place of work is at business premises the postal address of which is situated in the roads specified hereunder in such cases as may be specially approved by the Council;

"residents' parking permit" means a residents' permit issued under the provisions of Part J of this Order, and

"residents' permit holder" means a person to whom such a permit has been issued;

"road" means the full width of any length of highway or of any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes;

"restricted road" means the roads, lengths of road or sides of road (including any footway or verge and the perimeter of any central reservation, roundabout or traffic island) specified in the First, Second, Third, Fourth or Fifth Schedules to this Order:-

PROVIDED that the expression "restricted road" shall not for the purposes of this Order include any designated parking place or any authorised parking place described in the various Schedules to this Order and not suspended under the provisions of Article 39.

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, section 64 of the Act of 1984;

"traffic warden" means a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of section 95 of the Act of 1984;

PART A GENERAL

"visitors' parking permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Part K of this Order and

"visitors' permit holder" means a person to or for whom such permit has been issued.

- (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires: -
- (a) any reference to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order,
- (b) any reference to a numbered or lettered paragraph or sub-paragraph is a reference to the paragraph or sub-paragraph bearing that number or letter in the Article or Schedule or (in the case of a sub-paragraph) paragraph in which the reference occurs, and
- (c) any reference to a Table, or to a numbered Table, is a reference to the Table, or to the Table bearing that number, in the Article or Schedule in which that reference occurs.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment;
- (4) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or by or under any other enactment;
- (5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART B

Prohibitions and Restrictions on the waiting of vehicles or the loading or unloading of vehicles

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME on ALL DAYS

3 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in Part 1 of the First Schedule to this Order.

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME on MONDAYS to SATURDAYS

4 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on Mondays to Saturdays in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in Part 2 of the First Schedule to this Order.

DAYTIME WAITING RESTRICTIONS

5 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in the Second Schedule to this Order on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item.

WAITING LIMITED TO 30 MINUTES

- 6 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in the Third Schedule to this Order on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item (hereinafter referred to as "the said hours")
 - (i) for a longer period than 30 minutes, or

(ii) if a period of less 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

WAITING LIMITED TO 60 MINUTES

7 (1) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in Part 1 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item (hereinafter referred to as "the said hours")

(i) for a longer period than 60 minutes, or

(ii) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

PART B PROHIBITIONS ON WAITING

(2) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to this Order on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item (hereinafter referred to as "the said hours")

(i) for a longer period than 60 minutes, or

(ii) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

WAITING LIMITED TO 2 HOURS

8 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in the Fifth Schedule to this Order on the days and between the times (hereinafter referred to as "the said hours") specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item

(i) for a longer period than 2 hours, or

(ii) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

PART C Protection of Bus Stops (Bus Stop Clearways)

BUS STOP CLEARWAYS

- 9 SAVE as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle, to wait during the specified hours in a bus stop area.
- 10 The Council are satisfied that, for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the specified roads, it is requisite that Section 3 (1) (b) of the Act of 1984 shall not apply to this Part of this Order.
- 11 Except as otherwise provided in Article 12 of this Order, if any provision of Article 9 of this Order conflicts with a provision of any other Article in this Order which grants an exemption from the provision, the provision of Article 9 shall apply.
- 12 Nothing in Article 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a bus stop area -
- (a) if the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the following purposes and whilst being so used it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the bus stop area;

(i) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(ii) for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, of any of the said lengths of road; or

(iii) for the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near any of the said lengths or sides of road of any sewer or any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications.

- (c) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle
 - (i) is required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident;
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

13 In this Part of the Order,

"bus stop area" means an area of carriageway of a specified road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram

1025.1 or 1025.3 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"specified hours" means the hours between 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. every day; and

"specified road" means any road or length of road or side of road specified in the Table to this Article.

PROHIBITION OF WAITING (EXCEPT DOCTORS)

14 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any restricted road or length of restricted road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in the Table on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item unless the vehicle is a Doctor's vehicle.

PROHIBITION OF WAITING (EXCEPT PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES)

15 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any road or length of road described in columns 1 and 2 of an item in the Table on the days and between the times specified in the corresponding columns 3 and 4 of that item, unless the vehicle is a public passenger vehicle.

PART E

Designation and Use of Parking Places

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

- 17 Each area on a highway comprising the lengths of carriageway described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order and, unless otherwise so described, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.8 metres, is designated as a residents' parking place.
- 18 The limits of each parking place and the limits of any parking space shall be indicated by a road marking of a kind shown in one of the diagrams of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994, appropriate to the position in which a vehicle may park.
- 19 The Council or a police constable in uniform may suspend a designated parking place or part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Part H of this Order.

USE OF RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES

20 (1) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any parking place specified in Part 1 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order unless it is a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position a valid residents' parking permit or a validated visitors' parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated.

(2) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.30am and 10.30am on Mondays to Fridays in any parking place specified in Part 2 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order unless it is a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position a valid residents' parking permit or a validated visitors' parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated.

CONDUCT OF PARKING PLACES

21 PROVIDED ALWAYS that the provisions of Part H of this Order shall apply to any designated parking place and, in the event of any contravention of, or non-compliance with, a provision of Part H of this Order, the person responsible shall be guilty of an offence.

ADMINISTRATION OF PARKING SCHEMES

- 22 The administration of any Residents' Parking Scheme shall be in accordance with the provisions of Part J of this Order.
- 23 The administration of any Visitors' Permit Scheme shall be in accordance with the provisions of Part K of this Order.

PART F

Authorisation and Use of Parking Places

AUTHORISATION OF PARKING PLACES

- 24 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway described in the Seventh Schedule to this Order is authorised as a parking place for disabled persons vehicles.
- 25 The limits of each parking place and the limits of any parking space shall be indicated by a road marking of a kind shown in one of the diagrams of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994, appropriate to the position in which a vehicle may park.
- 26 The Council or a police constable in uniform may suspend an authorised parking place or part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Part H of this Order.

USE OF DISABLED PERSONS VEHICLE PARKING PLACES

27 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the parking places specified in the Seventh Schedule to this Order unless it is a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge.

CONDUCT OF PARKING PLACES

28 PROVIDED ALWAYS that the provisions of Part H of this Order shall apply to any authorised parking place and, in the event of any contravention of, or non-compliance with, a provision of Part H of this Order, the person responsible shall be guilty of an offence.

PART G

Exemptions from prohibitions and restrictions

EXEMPTION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

29 Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

EXEMPTION FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING OF GOODS

30 Nothing in Parts B, D, E or F of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted road or in any parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle.

(2) Notwithstanding anything paragraph (1), the driver of a vehicle waiting for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

EXEMPTION FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES

31 Nothing in Part B of this Order shall apply to a licensed taxi, whilst plying for hire upon a duly authorised cab rank appointed by the Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council in accordance with the provisions of section 63(1) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 or any modification or re-enactment of the same for the time being in force and standing wholly within the limits of the marking for taxi ranks prescribed in diagram 1028.2 of Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994.

EXEMPTION FOR POLICE VEHICLES

32 Nothing in Part B of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any police vehicle to wait whilst standing wholly within the limits of the marking for police vehicle waiting places prescribed in diagram 1028.2 of Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994.

EXEMPTION FOR PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES

33 Nothing in Part B of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any public service vehicle to wait whilst standing wholly within the limits of the marking for public service vehicles waiting places prescribed in diagram 1025 to 1025.3 of Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994.

EXEMPTION FOR DOCTORS, NURSES, etc

34 Nothing in Part E of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any residents' parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable a registered medical practitioner, or a Midwife, a District Nurse or a Health Visitor registered under the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 to make a house call on a patient.

EXEMPTION FOR CLEANING etc

35 Nothing in Part E of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any residents' parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in

connection with posting or removing advertising material in the form of posters on or from, or for cleaning windows or chimneys, in premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting; or for the cleaning of telephone kiosks adjacent to the parking place.

GENERAL EXEMPTION FROM PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

- 36 Nothing in Parts B, D, E or F of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted road or in any parking place for so long as may be necessary for any of the following purposes -
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or to unload therefrom personal luggage;
- (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (c) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) any building operation or demolition; or
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road; or
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (iv) to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if the vehicle cannot be used for such a purpose without stopping on the length of road.
- (d) to enable the vehicle to be used for a purpose authorised and described on a permit issued by the Highway Manager on behalf of the Council provided such permit is displayed on the vehicle in the appropriate position;
- (e) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
- (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths or sides of road for so long as waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- (g) if the vehicle is waiting in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is -
 - (i) required by law to stop; or
 - (ii) obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control

DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES

- 37 Nothing in Articles 3 to 5 (inclusive) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road referred to in any of the said Articles 3 to 5 for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle that length of road)
- 38 Nothing in Articles 6 to 8 (inclusive) or 20 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons' vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge to wait without limit of time in any of the roads, lengths of road, sides of road or parking places referred to in the said Articles 6 to 8 or 20.

PART H

Conduct of Parking Places

SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES

- 39 (1) The Council may, by Notice or by Order, suspend the use of any parking place or any part thereof
- (a) if it is satisfied that use of that parking place should be restricted or prohibited by reason that works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road, or by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the highway, or
- (b) for the purpose of facilitating the movement or traffic or promoting its safety; or
- (c) for preventing obstruction of the streets on the occasion of any public procession rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed.

subject to such conditions or exceptions as they consider necessary.

(2) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than seven days the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary -

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety; or
- (b) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository; or
- (c) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
- (d) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.

PROVIDED ALWAYS that any person suspending the use of a parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Article shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended such traffic signs as are necessary to indicate that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

MISCELLANEOUS CONDITIONS

- 40 A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place
- (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining a road or the use of a road by other persons or so as to be a nuisance;
- (b) when such parking place has been closed in accordance with the provisions of the preceding Article of this Order.

- 41 The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 42 No person shall
- (a) sell, offer or exhibit for sale or hire any vehicle while it is in a parking place, or
- (b) use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills in handicraft or services in any capacity.

PROVIDED ALWAYS that this Article shall not be deemed to prohibit persons employed in connection with a licensed public service vehicle or a licensed taxi operation from plying for hire or accepting passengers for hire in accordance with any regulation or condition under which the service is required by law to operate;

PROVIDED ALSO that this Article shall not be deemed to prohibit the use of a vehicle in a parking place if goods are being sold or offered for sale from the vehicle by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationary pitch situated in the parking place.

43 No person shall carry out upon any vehicle while it is in a parking place any work of construction cleaning maintenance or repair except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking place.

MOVEMENT AND REMOVAL OF VEHICLES

44 (1) When a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of or non-compliance with any of the provisions of this Order a police constable or a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place.

(2) In case of an emergency a police constable or a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter the position of that vehicle in the parking place; or remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place to any place he thinks fit.

(3) Any person altering the position of a vehicle in, or removing a vehicle from, a parking place by virtue of the preceding paragraphs of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.

SAFE CUSTODY OF VEHICLES REMOVED FROM PARKING PLACES

45 When a police constable or a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of the preceding Article he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle

PART J

Provisions Relating to Residents' Parking Permits.

RESIDENTS' PARKING ZONES

- 46 (1) For the purposes of administering a Residents' Parking Scheme the Council shall define by name and unique reference code such parking zones as are necessary.
 - (2) The names, unique reference codes and addresses of premises which comprise each parking zone shall be as detailed in the Part 3 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order.

ELIGIBILITY FOR RESIDENTS' PERMITS

47 (1) Any resident who is the owner of a motor vehicle may apply to the Council for the issue of a residents' parking permit and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by the appropriate remittance.

(2) For the purposes of this Part of the Order "owner" means a person in whose name the vehicle is registered, or in the case of leased or company owned vehicles, the person who is entitled to use that vehicle.

APPLICATIONS FOR RESIDENTS' PERMITS

48 On receipt of any application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this part of the Order the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 47 may issue to the applicant one residents' parking permit for the leaving in a parking place of the vehicle to which such residents' parking permit relates by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward

PROVIDED ALWAYS that, subject to the provisions of Article 55, the Council shall not issue to any resident a permit which would be valid for any period during which any other permit issued to that resident extends.

CHARGES FOR RESIDENTS PERMITS

49 For the purposes of this Part of the Order "appropriate remittance" means a remittance for the sum of £5.00 for any twelve month period.

REFUND OF CHARGES FOR RESIDENTS PERMITS

50 A resident's permit holder who surrenders a permit to the Council before the permit becomes valid shall be entitled to a full refund of the charge paid in respect of the issue thereof.

VERIFICATION OF PARTICULARS

51 The Council may at any time require an applicant for a residents' parking permit or a permit holder to produce to an Officer of the Council such evidence in respect of that application or any residents' parking permit issued by them as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them or that the permit is valid.

TRANSFER OF PERMIT ON CHANGE OF VEHICLE

52 A residents' parking permit shall be available for use only on the vehicle in respect of which it is issued but in the event of the permit holder disposing of such vehicle he shall be entitled to have the residents' parking permit issued for the remainder of the twelve month period in respect of any substitute vehicle and the Council, upon being satisfied as to the change of vehicles shall upon the surrender of the current permit issue a replacement permit and upon such issue the current permit shall become invalid.

TERMINATION OF RIGHTS

53 The Council shall be entitled to terminate all rights granted by the residents' parking permit if at any time there is any contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order WITHOUT PREJUDICE to any other rights of the Council against the Parking Permit holder in respect of the breach of condition giving rise to the termination of the rights granted by that residents' parking permit.

PROVIDED ALSO where a permit is issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque and the cheque is subsequently dishonoured, the permit shall cease to be of any effect and the Council shall by notice in writing served on the person to whom such permit was issued by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the resident's permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, require that person to surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

SURRENDER, WITHDRAWAL AND VALIDITY OF RESIDENTS' PARKING PERMITS

54 (1) A residents' parking permit shall not be assigned or transferred to any other person except as hereinafter provided but a permit holder may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender a permit on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article.

(2) The Council may, by notice in writing served on the permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a permit if it appears to the Council that any one of the events set out in paragraphs

(3) (a), (b) or (c) of this Article has occurred and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt to the aforementioned notice.

(3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:-

(a) the parking permit holder ceasing to be a resident in the Parking Zone as described in Part 3 of the Sixth Schedule to this Order for which the residents' parking permit in question was issued;

(b) the parking permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the parking permit was issued;

(c) the vehicle in respect of which the parking permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in Article 47 of this Order.

(d) the issue of a revised permit or a duplicate permit by the council under the provisions of the next following Article of this Order;

(e) the permit ceasing to be valid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article.

(f) the withdrawal of such permit by the Council under paragraph (2) of this Article;

(4) WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the foregoing provisions of this Article, a permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified thereon or on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article, whichever is earlier.

(5) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Article shall affect the validity of or require the surrender of or enable the Council to withdraw the permit or not renew it on the grounds that the event set out in paragraph (3) (b) of this Article has occurred if the permit holder has duly applied to the Council for the permit to be amended pursuant to Article 52 of this Order.

ISSUE OF DUPLICATE PERMITS

55 (1) If a permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council or apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the Council, upon the receipt of the permit, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the permit which it duplicates shall become invalid.

(2) If a permit is lost or destroyed the permit holder may apply to the council for the issue of a duplicate and the Council, upon being satisfied as to the loss or destruction shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the permit shall become invalid.

(3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate permit and an application therefor as if it were a permit or as the case may be an application therefor.

PART K

Provisions Relating to Visitors' Parking Permits.

VISITORS' PARKING PERMITS

56 Any resident may apply to the Council for the issue of one or more visitors' parking permits for a vehicle or vehicles of the classes described in Article 47 of this Order and belonging to a person or persons visiting that resident and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by the appropriate remittance.

CHARGES FOR VISITORS' PERMITS

57 For the purposes of this Part of the Order "appropriate remittance" means a remittance for the sum of £1 for each permit applied for. Each permit shall be valid for a maximum period of 14 days.

APPLICATIONS FOR VISITORS' PERMITS

- 58 On receipt of any application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this part of the Order and of the remittance specified the previous Article the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident shall issue to the applicant one or more visitors' parking permits for the leaving of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in a parking space in any parking place in the Parking Zone to which such visitors' parking permit relates.
- 59 The Council may at any time require an applicant for a visitors' parking permit to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of that application as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them.

VALIDATION and USE OF VISITORS' PERMITS

60 A visitors' parking permit shall be valid as if it were a residents' parking permit issued by the Council pursuant to Part J of this Order if and only if on the face of the permit there is indicated as required the day, date and month of the first occasion upon which the permit is being used and the face of the permit has been inscribed with the registration mark of the vehicle and no other writing or remark.

PART K PROVISIONS RELATING TO VISITORS' PERMITS

- B. The Borough of Tonbridge and Malling (Consolidation of Traffic Orders) (Various Roads, Tonbridge and Hildenborough) Order 1986 Shall have effect as though Schedules 1 to 42 of the Order were replaced with Schedules 1 to 8 of this Order.
- C. The Orders set out in the first column of the Table shall be modified or revoked to the extent specified in the second column of the Table
