The Minister of Transport in exercise of his powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in that length of the London-Folkstone- Dover Trunk Road (A.20) at Addington in the Rural District of Talling in the County of Kent, which extends from a point 240 yards east of its junction with Aldon Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 425 yards.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary:-

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

(b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;

(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so specified, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraphy Act 1873(c); or

(d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

3. The Interpretation Act 1983(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> August 1969, and may be cited as the Trunk Road (East of Aldon Road, Addington, Kent) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969.
