

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING
AND PROVISION OF PARKING) ORDER 2001
(AMENDMENT NO 134) ORDER 2012**

Trafford Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

PART I - GENERAL

1. This Order shall come into operation on 23rd July 2012 and may be cited as the Borough of Trafford (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking Order 2001)(Amendment No 134) Order 2012.
2. This Order forms an amendment to the provisions of the Borough of Trafford (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Order 2001 ("the 2001 Order").
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. The expressions, definitions and interpretations specified in Article 4 of the 2001 Order shall apply equally to this Order.

PART II - AMENDMENTS

5. The 2001 Order is hereby amended to include the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, with the following provisions denoted by the corresponding codes:-

6. The provisions of Articles 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the 2001 Order apply to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
7. Article 4(1) to the 2001 Order is hereby amended to include the following expressions and meanings:

“2002 Regulations” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and a reference to a traffic sign or road marking shown in a diagram in a Schedule to those Regulations is to a sign or marking of the size, colour or type prescribed by those Regulations and except where a particular version is specified, as shown in the diagram or varied in accordance with those Regulations;

“Disabled person’s vehicle” means a vehicle lawfully displaying in a conspicuous position a disabled person’s badge and which is a vehicle, which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England) Regulations 2000 to be included in an Order under the 1984 Act, has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or, as the case may be, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers;

“Dwelling House” means a dwelling house or part of a dwelling house used for residential occupation and shall include a flat;

“Event Day Controlled Hours” means:
Two hours before the expected start time, during and 1 hour after the actual finish time of a football match or event on those days upon which there is held:

 - i) At Old Trafford Football Ground, any football match involving Manchester United Football Club;
 - ii) At Old Trafford Football Ground, any football match not involving Manchester United Football Club;
 - iii) At Old Trafford Football Ground any event, whether sporting or non-sporting, which, in the opinion of the Corporate Director Environment Transport and Operations, or officer of the Council holding that post for the time being or any other suitably qualified officer of the Council duly

authorised by him/her or authorised by the Council to carry out such functions, is likely to benefit from the scheme being in operation;

- iv) At Old Trafford Cricket Ground, any cricket match involving or not involving Lancashire Cricket Club, which, in the opinion of the Corporate Director Environment Transport and Operations, or officer of the Council holding that post for the time being or any other suitably qualified officer of the Council duly authorised by him/her or authorised by the Council to carry out such functions, is likely to benefit from the scheme being in operation;
- v) At Old Trafford Cricket Ground any event, whether sporting or non-sporting, which, in the opinion of the Corporate Director Environment Transport and Operations, or officer of the Council holding that post for the time being or any other suitably qualified officer of the Council duly authorised by him/her or authorised by the Council to carry out such functions, is likely to benefit from the scheme being in operation;

“Goods Vehicle” means a motor vehicle (not being a passenger vehicle) constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description or a trailer so constructed or adapted;

“Penalty charge” and “Reduced penalty charge” means a charge set by the Council under provisions of Section 74 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 in accordance with guidance given by the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid in the manner described in the penalty charge notice within 28 days of the date of the notice or 14 days of the date of the notice in the case of the reduced penalty charge;

“Penalty charge notice” means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the Road Traffic Act 1991;

“Permit holder” means a person to whom a parking permit has been issued by the Council under the provisions of the Order;

“Permitted hours” means the period during which parking is permitted at a parking place under the provisions of this Order;

“Principal place of residence” means a place where the applicant for a resident’s parking permit or disabled resident’s parking permit stays overnight for at least four nights per week during a period of at least 10 months per year

“Resident” means a person whose principal place of residence is at premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of street described in a Schedule in this Order;

“Residents parking permit” means a parking permit issued to a Resident by the Council under the provisions of this Order.

“Residents parking place” means any area of highway in a Schedule to this Order

“Traffic Regulation Order” means any Order made by the Council under The Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or previous road traffic legislation;

“Traffic sign” means any object or device (whether fixed or portable) for conveying, to traffic on roads or any specified class of traffic, warnings, information, requirements, restrictions or prohibitions of any description: -

(a) specified by regulations made by the Secretaries of State charged with general responsibility under the Act of 1984 in relation to England and Wales and Scotland respectively acting jointly; or

(b) authorised by the Secretary of State and any line or mark on a road for so conveying such warnings, information, requirements, restrictions or prohibitions.

“Visitors parking permit” means a parking permit issued to a resident for use by visitors by the Council under the provisions of this Order;

8. The 2001 Order is hereby amended to include the following:
Article 23. Contravening The Order And Penalty Charge

- i) If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable.
- ii) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice showing the information required by Section 66 of The Road Traffic Act 1991 may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of Section 66 of that Act.

9. Save as amended by this Order the provisions of the 2001 Order remain in force.
