THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby amends the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Cranbrook) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and unloading) Consolidating Order 1997 as follows :

For the lengths of roads listed below, Part B of the schedule shall be amended to:

Revoke

No loading or unloading between 8.30am and 9.15am, between 9.30am and 4.14pm and between 4.30pm and 6.30pm

1. Stone Street, Cranbrook:

on its south west side from a point 64 metres south east of its junction with High Street to a point 72 metres north-west of its junction with St David's Bridge.

Citation and Commencement

This order shall come into operation on the 27th November 2006 and may be cited as the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Cranbrook) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Consolidating Order 1997 (Amendment Order) 2006
