

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
ZONE HA (PERMIT PARKING) (TUNBRIDGE WELLS) ORDER 2017
(AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 2019

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 Part 6 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of March 2020 and may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL ZONE HA (PERMIT PARKING)(TUNBRIDGE WELLS) ORDER 2017 (AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 2019" ("this Order").

Amendments to the 2017 Order

The "Kent County Council Zone HA (Permit Parking)(Tunbridge Wells) Order 2017" ("the 2017 Order") is hereby amended as follows:-

1. In the Schedule to the 2017 Order, 'Permit holders only Monday to Friday, 10am to 12 noon and 2pm to 4pm' the following shall be inserted:

Road	Side	Definition
Boundary Road, Tunbridge Wells	North side	From a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Forest Road to a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Hawkenbury Road
	South side	In the layby outside nos. 14 and 16 Boundary Road
Dorset Road Tunbridge Wells	North-east side	From a point 25 metres south-east of its junction with Forest Road to its south-eastern extent
	South-west side	From a point 38 metres south-east of its junction with Forest Road to a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Napier Road
	South-west side	From a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Napier Road to its south-eastern extent
Hawkenbury Close Tunbridge Wells	Both sides	From a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Hawkenbury Road for its entire length
Hawkenbury Road Tunbridge Wells	South-west side	From a point 30 metres south-east of its junction with Forest Road to a point 75 metres south-east of that junction
	North-east side	From a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Hawkenbury Close to a point 28 metres north-west of its junction with Boundary Road
	North-east side	From a point 12 metres south-east of its junction with Boundary Road to a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Hawkenbury Mead

Napier Road Tunbridge Wells	North side	Between a point 12 metres east of its junction with Forest Road and a point 20 metres west of its junction with Nelson Road
	North side	Between a point 69 metres east of its junction with Nelson Road and a point 10 metres west of its junction with Polesden Road
	North side	Between a point 10 metres east of its junction with Polesden Road and its junction with Dorset Road
	South side	From its junction with Nelson Road to its junction with Dorset Road
Nelson Road Tunbridge Wells	South-east side	From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Napier Road to a point 30 metres south-west of its junction with Forest Road
Whybourne Crest (east-west spur) Tunbridge Wells	North side	Between a point 30 metres east of its junction with Forest Road to its most eastern point
	South side	Between a point 30 metres east of its junction with Forest Road and a point 10 metres west of its junction with Whybourne Crest (north-south spur)
	South side	From a point 10 metres east of its junction with Whybourne Crest (north-south spur) to its eastern most extent
Whybourne Crest (north-south spur) Tunbridge Wells	Both sides	Between a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Whybourne Crest (east-west spur) and a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Forest Way

2. In the APPENDIX to the 2017 Order the following shall be inserted:

Road	Addresses eligible for Permits
Beech Close	All
Forest Road	Even numbers 92 to 126 Odd numbers 1 to 113, 123 and 125
Polesden Road	All
Whybourne Crest	All

The provisions of this Order shall prevail over the provisions of any previous Order.
