#### **Amendments**

- 3. All references to 'Union House' car parks in Article 15 shall be removed and replaced with 'Pantiles' car parks.
- 4. In PART ONE of the SCHEDULE to the Principal Order, 'Union House (covered)' and 'Union House (uncovered) car parks in column 1 shall be removed and replaced with the following:
