# THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TUNBRIDGE WELLS BOROUGH) (CAR CLUB PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2015 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 Part 6 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

#### **Preamble**

This Order shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December 2015 and may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)(TUNBRIDGE WELLS)(CAR CLUB PARKING SPACES) ORDER 2015

#### **Interpretation**

(1) In this Order:-

"car club"	means an organisation that manages and administers a car club for the purpose of hiring passenger vehicles to subscribers to that organisation and has been approved in writing by the Council or its agent for the purposes of this Order
"car club parking place"	means any length of road specified in Part One of the Schedule to this Order
"car club vehicle"	means a vehicle of a type approved by the Council or its agent for the use of persons who have paid any relevant membership or other club fee
"civil enforcement area"	means an area where civil enforcement of parking restrictions can be enforced as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004
"car club permit"	means a permit issued by the Council or its agent to the car club operator
"civil enforcement officer"	means a person employed by Tunbridge Wells Borough Council in pursuance of powers granted by the Traffic Management Act 2004 (Civil Enforcement Area)
"disabled persons badge"	has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000;
"disabled persons vehicle"	means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled persons badge;
"junction"	means the intersection point of the centrelines, or projected centrelines, of the roads specified
"owner" and "traffic sign"	have the same meanings as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984
"parking disc"	means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, 125mm in diameter coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;
"parking exemption certificate"	a certificate or other means of identification which has been issued by the local traffic authority or its appointed agents on which is shown the index

"relevant position"	means;
relevant position	means,
	<ol> <li>in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disabled persons badge is exhibited thereon so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle;</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disabled persons badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle;</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>in the case of a parking exemption certificate, in a conspicuous position inside the vehicle so that the certificate is visible in full and legible from outside the vehicle.</li> </ol>
"specified road"	means the road or roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

### Car Club Parking Spaces – Restrictions Imposed

- (2) Each of the lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a parking place for any vehicle belonging to a car club and which displays in the relevant position a valid car club permit.
- (3) Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a car club parking place at any time unless:-

(i) it is a car club vehicle and displays a valid car club permit, and

(ii) it is parked with every part of the vehicle on the carriageway and so that it is entirely within the limits of the car club parking place as marked

(4) No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a car club parking place:-

(i) in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near it or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services

(ii) for cooking, sleeping or camping purposes

#### **Exemptions**

- (5) Nothing in Article (3) of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area) in relation to:-
  - (a) a vehicle in actual use for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes;
  - (b) anything done with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and employed by the Council or its agent;
  - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property when required to do so by law;
  - (d) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of any local authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
  - (e) a vehicle being used for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a part or whole of the restricted area:

- (f) a vehicle being used for the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus within the restricted area;
- (g) a vehicle waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.

#### Suspension of use of a Car Club Parking Place

- (6) The Council, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform may suspend the use of a car club parking place or any part of it whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary
- (7) Any person suspending the use of a car club parking place or any part of it in accordance with the preceding Article shall place thereupon or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that car club parking place or the part of it the use of which is suspended, a traffic sign and/or marking indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

#### **Contraventions of the Order**

- (8) If a parking contravention (as defined in the Traffic Management Act 2004) is committed in respect of any of the provisions of this Order a Penalty Charge will be payable.
- (9) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge is payable a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer.

#### Variations and Revocations

- (10) The variations to existing Orders listed in PART TWO of the Schedule to this Order will have effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015
- (11) The parts of Orders listed in PART THREE of the schedule to this Order are hereby revoked and will cease to have any effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015.
- (12) The Kent County Council (Mount Pleasant Road, Tunbridge Wells)(Car Club Parking Places)(Experimental) Order 2014 shall be revoked in its entirety with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015
- (13) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984.
- (14) The provisions of this order shall prevail over the provisions of any previous order.

### **Commencement and citation**

This Order may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TUNBRIDGE WELLS BOROUGH) (CAR CLUB PARKING PLACES) No.1 ORDER 2015" and shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015.
