

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL  
(CLEVELAND, ROYAL TUNBRIDGE WELLS)  
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)  
ORDER 2011**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of their powers and under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of the Schedule 9 to the Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

**Citation and Commencement and Revocation**

1. Exemptions would be provided in Schedule 1 to the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for disabled badge holders, for the loading and unloading of goods, for enabling work to be carried out in or adjacent the road and for emergency service vehicles.
  
2. This Order may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (Cleveland, Royal Tunbridge Wells) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of November 2011 and will revoke the existing restriction in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Schedule 1  
**No waiting at any time**

Name of road	Length of road effected
CLEVELAND	On the western side from the junction with Sandrock Road for a distance of 27 metres in a northerly direction. ✓
CLEVELAND	On the eastern side from the junction with Sandrock Road for a distance of 34 metres in a northerly direction. ✓
CLEVELAND	On the eastern side from a point 85 metres north and northwest of the junction with Sandrock Road for a distance of 52 metres generally in a northerly direction.
CLEVELAND	On the eastern side between points 15 metres south west of the access road between Nos. 24 and 26 to a point 15 metres north east of that junction. ✓
CLEVELAND (Access road between Nos. 24 and 26)	On the north eastern side from the junction with Cleveland for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction. ✓  On the south western side from the junction with Cleveland for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction. ✓

Schedule 2 ?

Name of road	Length of road effected
CLEVELAND	On both sides – from the junction with Sandrock Road to a point 15 metres north of the junction.
